1           A SENATE RESOLUTION to congratulate Lynn Staley on  
2 her retirement as Superintendent of Liberty Christian School in  
3 Anderson.

4           *Whereas, Liberty Christian School was founded in 1976*  
5 *and has now celebrated its 40<sup>th</sup> anniversary;*

6           *Whereas, Lynn Staley was hired to teach kindergarten when*  
7 *classes were held in a donated building and there were only*  
8 *four grades and 24 students;*

9           *Whereas, The school now houses 550 students from*  
10 *preschool through grade 12 and is accredited by the*  
11 *Association of Christian Schools International;*

12           *Whereas, Lynn believes the success of Liberty has been the*  
13 *result of a sense of spiritual clarity and a strong sense of*  
14 *family; and*

15           *Whereas, Lynn believes the strong family connection is*  
16 *reflected in her own journey with the school. She taught there*  
17 *untill the mid 1980s before leaving to go into business and*  
18 *earning a doctorate. Lynn was ready to retire when she was*
