I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

8	Whereas, HHFF aids military families dealing with death,
9	deployment and loss, as well as helping with basic expenses
10	during transition;
11	Whereas, Additionally, HHFF assists those severely
12	wounded who are in need of equipment or housing
13	modifications;
14	Whereas, HHFF also helps children with life enrichment
15	programs, mentor programs, and counseling;
16	Whereas, HHFF is a volunteer-driven 501(3)c
17	organization, and the 2015 Lincoln Award winner, given to the
18	top military charity by Southwest Veterans Chamber of

2	Whereas, In 2016, HHFF embarked on a 3,100 mile walk
3	across America to raise awareness of military families and to
4	raise funds to build a retreat house and Post Traumatic Stress
5	Disorder center that HHFF wants to put in central Indiana to
6	assist military families, to honor Gold Star families, and to help
7	end the epidemic of 22 veteran suicides a day;
8	Whereas, David Roth, a 20-year veteran of IMPD and
9	former Chairman of the Board for HHFF, and Kevin Winton,
10	a 20-plus year teacher at Beech Grove Middle School, walked
11	the entire trip from Atlantic City to San Francisco, which began
12	on April 28 and lasted until August 26;
13	Whereas, Others who walked included Staff Sgt. Shannon,
14	former HHFF CEO Darin Fishburn, HHFF co-founder Rod
15	Smith, HHFF Communications Director Paul Gable, and 9-
16	year-old Brenden Gable; and
17	Whereas, It is fitting that the Indiana Senate honors and
18	commends HHFF for its charitable efforts which help our
19	veterans and military families: Therefore,
