SENATE RESOLUTION ____

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring Indiana's women
2	veterans.
3	Whereas, Women are an essential part of the United States
4	military and the profession of arms, having served throughout
5	the history of the United States of America;
6	Whereas, Many women, unable to serve lawfully in the
7	profession of arms, provided critical support to the United
8	States Army during the American Revolutionary War as nurses,
9	seamstresses, and cooks;
0	Whereas, The U.S. Army reports that women did fight
1	alongside their husbands in combat or disguised themselves as
2	men in order to serve, and women took an active role providing
3	the military with intelligence on enemy troop movements
4	throughout the colonies and along the frontier;
5	Whereas, The U.S. Army reports that women served once
6	again during the Civil War in critical roles as nurses and aides
7	in addition to an estimated 400 women who secretly enlisted as

soldiers to fight in the Union or Confederate armies;

1	Whereas, The U.S. Army established a permanent Nurse
2	Corps in 1901, recognizing the skilled role of nurses in the
3	military, especially during the Spanish-American War and an
4	outbreak of typhoid fever, when an estimated 1,500 contract
5	nurses served in Army and Navy general hospitals and
6	throughout the Northern Hemisphere during the war effort;
7	Whereas, An estimated 25,000 women between the ages of
8	21 and 69 served overseas during World War I and the role of
9	women in the military increased in the Army, Navy, and
10	Marines as World War II, and the United States' involvement
11	began in earnest;
12	Whereas, More than 60,000 Army nurses served around the
13	world, with an estimated 140,000 women serving in the U.S.
14	Army and the Women's Army Corps during World War II;
15	Whereas, The U.S. Army reports that more than 1,000
16	women flew aircraft for the Women's Airforce Service Pilots
17	during that same period;
18	Whereas, The role of women in the United States military
19	and their voluntary service continued to grow over the decades,
20	especially in nursing, and an estimated 170,000 women served
21	on active duty by 1980 according to the Women in Military
22	Service Memorial Foundation;
23	Whereas, The United States, acknowledging the value and
24	strength of women in the military, offered females the
25	opportunity to serve in combat roles throughout the armed
26	forces in 2015; and
27	Whereas, Women today serve and fight alongside their
28	fellow soldiers, sailors, airmen, marines and guardians on
29	behalf of the United States of America: Therefore,



1	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
2	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
3	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate honors Indiana's
4	women veterans for their service to the state of Indiana and the
5	United States of America.
6	SECTION 2. That the Indiana Senate joins all Hoosiers in
7	celebrating Women Veterans Recognition Day on June 12,
8	2021.
9	SECTION 3. That the Secretary of the Senate shall transmit
10	copies of this resolution to Veteran Support Council, Indiana
11	and Tri-State Women Veterans for distribution.
