MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council
2 to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of
3 medical reimbursement under worker's compensation for
4 ambulatory surgical centers.

5 *Whereas, ambulatory surgical centers (ASCs) are defined*
6 *by the Medicare Payment Advisory Commission (MedPac) as*
7 *free standing or hospital operated ambulatory surgical centers*
8 *that are "distinct facilities that furnish ambulatory surgery";*

9 *Whereas, MedPac reports that ASCs provide outpatient*
10 *procedures to patients who do not require an overnight stay*
11 *after the procedure and which resulted in nearly 5,500 ASCs*
12 *treating 3.4 million fee-for-service Medicare beneficiaries in*
13 *2015; and*

14 *Whereas, ASCs operate throughout Indiana serving Hoosiers*
15 *with various healthcare needs: Therefore,*

16 *Be it resolved by the Senate*
17 *of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

18 SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to
19 the appropriate study committee the topic of medical
20 reimbursement under worker's compensation for ambulatory
21 surgical centers.
