## SENATE RESOLUTION \_\_\_\_

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

| 1  | A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring the Lincoln                       |

| 2  | Amphitheatre in Lincoln City, Indiana, on the 35th anniversary |
| 3  | of its inaugural season.                                       |
| 4  | Whereas, As one of the largest roofed amphitheatres in the     |
| 5  | United States, the Lincoln Amphitheatre seats 1,500 in an      |
| 6  | outdoor venue that is close to President Abraham Lincoln's     |
| 7  | childhood home;  |
| 8  | Whereas, From the age of seven to twenty-one, Abraham          |
| 9  | Lincoln lived, worked, and studied in Lincoln City;            |
| 10 | Whereas, The amphitheatre, which is located in Lincoln         |
| 11 | State Park, was dedicated in 1987 and served as the home of    |
| 12 | the "Young Abe Lincoln" outdoor musical drama for 19 years;    |
| 13 | Whereas, In its inaugural season, the Lincoln Club of          |
| 14 | Southern Indiana and the Lincoln Boyhood Drama Association     |
| 15 | operated the amphitheatre and produced Young Abe Lincoln,      |
| 16 | which was presented for the final time in August 2005, when    |
| 17 | funding was lost;  |
| 18 | Whereas, Local efforts to restore funding for a Lincoln-       |



| 1  | based production were successful in 2007, after the Indiana    |

| 2  | General Assembly approved \$1.6 million for facility upgrades  |
| 3  | and kicked off a production of a new Abraham Lincoln play;     |
| 4  | Whereas, Following a lengthy closure during the 2013           |
| 5  | season, the Indiana Destination Development Corporation        |
| 6  | (formerly known as the Indiana Office of Tourisn               |
| 7  | Development) and the Indiana Department of Natura              |
| 8  | Resources began a partnership in support of the amphitheatre   |
| 9  | that led to a successful 2016 season;                          |
| 10 | Whereas, Since 2016, the Lincoln Amphitheatre has hosted       |
| 11 | a variety of bands and performances and has experienced        |
| 12 | growth in both revenue and attendance in each successive       |
| 13 | operational year, including an official attendance topping     |
| 14 | 26,000 with tickets sold in at least 27 states and 181 Indiana |
| 15 | municipalities in 2021; and                                    |
| 16 | Whereas, The 2022 season is expected to continue the 35        |
| 17 | year legacy of art and music that the Indiana Destination      |
| 18 | Development Corporation and the Lincoln City Amphitheatre      |
| 19 | have achieved and will continue to showcase the life and       |
| 20 | history of Abraham Lincoln in southern Indiana and Kentucky    |
| 21 | Therefore,   |
| 22 | Be it resolved by the Senate of the                            |
| 23 | General Assembly of the State of Indiana:                      |
| 24 | SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate congratulates the           |
| 25 | Lincoln Amphitheatre on the occasion of the 35th anniversary   |
| 26 | of its inaugural season, and hopes that the amphitheatre wil   |

continue to see success for many years to come.
