SENATE RESOLUTION

MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring the China
2 Philanthropy Leadership Initiative for its work in improving
3 cross-cultural communication of philanthropy and promoting
4 the development of philanthropy in China.

5 *Whereas, The China Philanthropy Leadership Initiative is*
6 *comprised of Indiana University School of Philanthropy*
7 *students with an interest in philanthropy and nonprofit*
8 *organizations;*

9 *Whereas, CPLI's mission is to improve cross-cultural*
10 *communication of philanthropy and promote the development*
11 *of philanthropy in China by creating a platform to engage*
12 *young philanthropic practitioners and scholars, providing*
13 *resources and perspectives to these individuals, and by*
14 *inspiring practices and leadership through Chinese and*
15 *American experiences;*

16 *Whereas, Between 2011 and 2013 alone, CPLI put on over*
17 *20 seminars on philanthropy, religion, and China, along with*
18 *numerous other speaker series and panel discussions to engage*
19 *others in and carry out CPLI's mission;*



1 *Whereas, Members of CPLI recently visited the Cass*
2 *County Community Foundation to learn the details of how a*
3 *charity operates in Indiana and also volunteered to translate at*
4 *the Zhejiang-Indiana conference to strengthen the partnership*
5 *of our two regions; and*

6 *Whereas, CPLI's efforts and goals help bring together*
7 *students and cultures and will lead to the organization's*
8 *philanthropic vision of implementing the practices learned*
9 *through CPLI in China becoming a reality in the future:*
10 *Therefore,*

11 *Be it resolved by the Senate of the*
12 *General Assembly of the State of Indiana:*

13 SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate honors the China
14 Philanthropy Leadership Initiative for its work in improving cross-
15 cultural communication in philanthropy and promoting the
16 development of philanthropy in China.
