MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

4	Whereas, Millions of children rely on school buses to transport them
5	to and from school safely each day;
6	Whereas, The issue of seat belts on school buses has a long history
7	of debate in Indiana;
8	Whereas, Seat belts are not currently required in school buses in the
9	state of Indiana;
10	Whereas, The National Highway Traffic Safety Administration
11	(NHTSA) has now indicated that the best practice is for children on a
12	school bus to wear a three point seat belt; and
13	Whereas, The safety of our children in school buses is of utmost
14	importance, and it is, therefore, incumbent upon us to investigate
15	thoroughly how we might keep our children safe and to fully
16	understand all aspects of a potential mandate to install three point seat
17	belts in all school buses: Therefore,
18	Be it resolved by the Senate
19	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
20	SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to the
21	appropriate study committee the topic of school buses equipped with
22	three point seat belts.
