MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION recognizing Mina Starsiak 2 Hawk and Karen Laine for their efforts to revitalize historic 3 homes around Indianapolis and their work rebuilding and 4 rehabilitating the Fountain Square and Bates-Hendricks 5 neighborhoods.

6 Whereas, Karen Laine and Mina Starsiak Hawk are a 7 mother-daughter team who co-founded Two Chicks and a 8 Hammer, Inc., after they began remodeling homes around 9 Indianapolis in 2007;

Whereas, The mission of Two Chicks and a Hammer is to revitalize Indianapolis' downtown neighborhoods, and, by focusing on their own neighborhoods of Fountain Square and Bates-Hendricks, Karen and Mina are helping to restore these parts of Indianapolis to their former glory, one property at a time;

Whereas, In 2014, Karen and Mina caught the attention of
High Noon Entertainment - the producer of many popular
unscripted televison shows - and soon found themselves the
stars of the HGTV series "Good Bones";

Whereas, The series follows Karen and Mina, along with
 the members of their family-focused team, as they buy homes in

- 3 serious disrepair and transform them into stunning remodels;
- Whereas, Since their show premiered in 2016, there have
 been 70 episodes over six seasons, each of them demonstrating
 Karen and Mina's philosophy that people can do well by doing
 good in their neighborhood;
- 8 Whereas, Research done by Visit Indy shows that Good 9 Bones - through its beautiful depictions of city landscapes and 10 tireless promotion by Mina - is a powerful source of tourism for 11 the City of Indianapolis;

Whereas, In addition to lifting property values, rejuvenating neighborhoods, and stoking civic pride, Mina and Karen have founded a nonprofit, Two Chicks Give Back, that will provide financial assistance to residents in the neighborhoods they have improved;

- Whereas, Even though Karen retired from the company in
 2019, she still plays an important role in the series, while Mina
 continues to grow the business, including the renovation of
 roughly 14 houses per year; and
- Whereas, Through their hard work and dedication to their
 ideals, Karen and Mina have demonstrated the effectiveness of
 social entrepreneurship as a tool for improving the lives of
 Hoosiers: Therefore,

Be it resolved by the Senate of the
