1           A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing the Honorable  
2           Judge James "Jim" William Long.

3           *Whereas, James "Jim" William Long passed away on*  
4           *March 14, 2021, at his home in Columbus, Indiana, surrounded*  
5           *by his family;*

6           *Whereas, Jim was born on January 24, 1936, to Cora Nell*  
7           *Long and Charles William Long in Columbus, Indiana;*

8           *Whereas, After graduating from Columbus North High*  
9           *School in 1953, Jim joined the United States Army and served*  
10          *until 1957 with the 29th Medical Detachment stationed in*  
11          *Göppingen, Germany;*

12          *Whereas, Jim later attended Franklin College and, upon*  
13          *completion of an undergraduate degree, went on to Indiana*  
14          *University School of Law where he earned a Juris Doctorate in*  
15          *1971;*

16          *Whereas, Jim was elected Judge of the Bartholomew*  
17          *Superior Court 1 from 1977 until 1989 when he returned to*
