## **SENATE RESOLUTION**

## MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the Legislative Counci
2	to assign to an appropriate study committee the topic of the
3	need to require access to "employee restrooms" for individuals
4	with certain medical conditions.
5	Whereas, Over one million Americans and an estimated
6	30,000 Hoosiers are suffering from Crohn's Disease and a
7	group of conditions referred to as Irritable Bowel Syndrome
8	which are chronic inflammatory conditions of the
9	gastrointestinal tract;
10	Whereas, Crohn's disease is a partially genetic condition
11	marked by an abnormal response by the body's immune system,
12	Whereas, Medical conditions like Crohn's Disease and
13	Irritable Bowel Syndrome are serious, chronic ailments that
14	can result in the need for immediate access to a restroom;
15	Whereas, In some circumstances, public restroom facilities
16	are not available, and onsite employee restrooms may not be
17	made available to individuals with an immediate need due to
18	concerns of liability, the possibility of theft, or safety; and

1	Whereas, Sixteen states, including all states that border
2	Indiana, have recently considered this issue and passed laws to
3	increase restroom access for individuals with certain medical
4	conditions: Therefore,
5	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
6	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
7	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate urges the Legislative
8	Council to assign to an appropriate study committee the topic of
9	restroom access for individuals with certain medical conditions and
10	appropriate protections for retailers that provide this access to
11	"employee only restrooms."
12	SECTION 2. The Secretary of the Senate is hereby directed to
13	transmit copies of this Resolution to Glenna Shelby and the Legislative
14	Council.
