MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1 A SENATE RESOLUTION memorializing Shelby Jacob
2 Schafer.

3 *Whereas, Shelby Jacob Schafer passed away February 10,*
4 *2020, in Indianapolis;*

5 *Whereas, Shelby was born in Huntingburg, Indiana, on*
6 *December 11, 1920, and graduated from Huntingburg High*
7 *School in 1939;*

8 *Whereas, In 1942, Shelby joined the United States Army,*
9 *and served as an Army Ranger during World War II where he*
10 *spent much of his service in the South Pacific;*

11 *Whereas, Shelby married Betty Boehm and together they*
12 *moved to South Bend, Indiana, where Shelby attended the*
13 *University of Notre Dame until his graduation in 1949;*

14 *Whereas, After graduation, Shelby and Betty first moved to*
15 *Richmond, Virginia, where they adopted their daughter, Shelby,*
16 *and later moved to Evansville, Indiana, where they adopted*

7 *Whereas, Shelby is survived by his daughters, Shelby and*
8 *Catherine, step-daughter Barb, step-son Rich, three*
