MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1           A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council to assign  
2 to the appropriate committee the topic of prohibiting persons convicted  
3 of a Level 6 felony from being sent to the Department of Correction.

4           *Whereas, Under current law, persons convicted of a Level*  
5 *6 felony cannot be sent to the Department of Correction;*

6           *Whereas, This practice may lead to overcrowding of local*  
7 *jails and additional costs to local governments; and*
