9	clarification: Therefore,
10	Be it resolved by the Senate
11	of the General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
12	SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to the
13	appropriate committee the topic of prohibiting persons convicted of a
14	Level 6 felony from being sent to the Department of Correction.
