1	A SENATE RESOLUTION congratulating the Bishop
2	Dwenger High School gymnastics team on winning the 2025
3	Indiana High School Athletic Association (IHSAA) state

5	Whereas, On March 15, 2025, the Bishop Dwenger
6	gymnastics team (the Saints) ended their season at Ball State
7	University's Worthen Arena in Muncie, Indiana, by winning
8	their sixth state title in program history and first since 2012;
9	Whereas, The Saints had a season-best of 113.125 points at
0	the Concordia Sectional and set a new program record by
1	achieving 113.800 points at the Huntington North Regional
2	before advancing to the State Finals;
3	Whereas, At the State Finals, the Saints faced off against
4	Valparaiso, Angola, Columbus North, Crown Point,
5	Homestead, New Palestine, Northwestern, and Bloomington
6	North High Schools;
7	Whereas, Junior Avery Gleave finished second in both the
8	vault and balance beam and placed third for the floor

1	sophomore Maria Szczepanski placed third in the uneven bars
2	and fourth in the vault, and Kobi Johnson got third in the vault,
3	Whereas, Kobi Johnson scored a 9.625 in her spectacular
4	floor performance, earning her an individual state title in the
5	event in addition to helping her team's overall score;
6	Whereas, Bishop Dwenger secured the championship after
7	hitting three of their four bar routines and having three of the
8	top four scores on vault, which expanded the team's lead from
9	0.250 to 1.700, and ending with an overall team score of
10	112.975;
11	Whereas, The Saints success is, in a large part, due to
12	Coach Rose Nix, who has been with the team for four decades
13	and has been the coach through each of the Saints state titles
14	and nine runner-up finishes; and
15	Whereas, The Bishop Dwenger Saints finished their 2025
16	season with their sixth overall state title, tying for second-most
17	in state history: Therefore,
18	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
19	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
20	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate congratulates the
21	Bishop Dwenger High School gymnastics team on winning the
