13	of Mayor Rock;
14	Whereas, John was a pioneer for young African Americans
15	in Anderson, and he inspired them to begin their careers in
16	government;

18	model for his family. He enjoyed being around family, riding
19	motorcycles, taking pictures, jazz music, and loved to travel;
