MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council
2	to assign to the appropriate study committee the topic of
3	mandated insurance coverage for Pediatric Autoimmune
4	Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with Streptococcal
5	Infections (PANDAS).
6	Whereas, PANDAS are disorders in which antibodies
7	attack the brain after fighting a streptococcal infection. The
8	symptoms commonly manifest as psychiatric disorders such as
9	obsessive-compulsive disorder, Tourette's, and other behavioral
10	symptoms;
11	Whereas, PANDAS may have detrimental effects on a
12	person's physical and financial well-being. The most promising
13	treatment option, called IV/IG Therapy (Intravenous
14	Immunoglobulin therapy) "resets" the immune system.
15	However, the expenses of this therapy often make it essentially
16	inaccessible to those who need it, as there is no mandated
17	insurance coverage for this treatment;
18	Whereas, When a person's diagnosis is not covered by their
19	insurance plan, it may cause serious financial problems that

often lead to further negative health outcomes. Many people in



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1	Indiana suffering from less common diagnoses understand the
2	challenges that commonly arise with limited insurance
3	coverage;
4	Whereas, A lack of consensus in the medical community
5	about the legitimacy of PANDAS has contributed to difficulties
6	in treating these disorders, much less providing insurance
7	coverage. However, the disorder is becoming more
8	well-recognized and in May 2019, the World Health
9	Organization will be voting to add PANDAS to the
10	International Medical Code;
11	Whereas, Indiana has already introduced legislation to
12	improve coverage for people suffering from PANDAS. In 2018
13	the Indiana General Assembly drafted Senate Bill 412, titled
14	"Coverage for Pediatric Neuropsychiatric Disorders", but the
15	bill was not granted a committee hearing;
16	Whereas, Other states have recognized the insurance
17	challenges that individuals with PANDAS are facing and have
18	responded with legislation. In 2017, Illinois passed House Bill
19	2721 to mandate coverage for PANDAS, and this policy was
20	partly a result of a 2016 law that convened an advisory board
21	to study PANDAS; and
22	Whereas, Indiana should study the issue of mandated
23	coverage for PANDAS. Studying the issue will help to advise
24	policy that could ensure all Hoosiers have the opportunity to
25	purchase insurance that will undeniably cover them in the event
26	that they are impacted by this type of disorder: Therefore,
27	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
28	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
29	SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to the
30	appropriate study committee the topic of mandated insurance coverage
31	for Pediatric Autoimmune Neuropsychiatric Disorders Associated with

Streptococcal Infections (PANDAS) in order to promote better
