5	Whereas, The Chesterton Trojans won the 2013-14 IHSAA
6	Boys Swimming and Diving State Championships on Saturday,
7	March 1, 2014, at the Indiana University Natatorium in
8	Indianapolis;
9	Whereas, This is the 2nd straight state title for Chesterton,
10	and their 4th in the last 7 seasons;
11	Whereas, The Trojans won half the events and earned 240
12	points at the championship,tcv/
13	due in part to two winning relay teams and two individual
14	titles;
15	Whereas, The team roster includes Patrick Curley, Andy
16	Hurst, Ethan Whitaker, Josh Ban Nevel, Nate Rodriguez, Gary
17	Kostbade, Jack Kurfman, Wesley Slaughter, Aaron Whitaker,
18	Jack Waller, Blake Pieroni, and Tony Kincaid;
19	Whereas, During the event, the Chesterton High School

1	team set two national records and a plethora of state records;
2	Whereas, Chesterton's 200 medley relay team, comprised
3	of Jack Wallar, Blake Pieroni, Aaron Whitaker, Gary Kostbade,
4	set the fastest time in national public high school history;
5	Whereas, The team of Aaron Whitaker, Blake Pieroni,
6	Patrick Curley, and Ethan Whitaker won the 400 freestyle
7	relay, swam a public school-record time in the preliminaries,
8	and became the first team in Indiana to break the three-minute
9	barrier in the event;
10	Whereas, Blake Pieroni repeated his championship title in
11	the 200 IM, won his third consecutive 100 freestyle title, and
12	was awarded the Herman F. Keller Mental Attitude Award; and
13	Whereas, Aaron Whitaker repeated his championship title
14	in two events: the 100 fly and 100 backstroke: Therefore,
15	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
