MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION urging the legislative council
2	to assign the topic of coverage for pharmacist care to an interim
3	study committee.
4	Whereas, Currently, pharmacists are able to provide
5	critical health care services, including tobacco cessation and
6	diabetes management, within their scope of practice;
7	Whereas, However, because pharmacists are not included
8	in the network of accident and sickness insurance policies,
9	those critical health care services, when performed by a
10	pharmacist, are not covered by a patient's insurance policy;
11	Whereas, Allowing pharmacists providing health care
12	services within their scope of practice to be included in
13	accident and sickness insurance networks will provide better,
14	more affordable access to health care in Indiana; and
15	Whereas, It is important that this issue be studied by an
16	appropriate study committee: Therefore,
17	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
18	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:



1	SECTION 1. That the legislative council is urged to assign to an
2	interim study committee the topic of coverage for pharmacist care.
3	SECTION 2. That the study committee, if assigned the topic, shall
4	issue to the legislative council a final report, in an electronic format
5	under IC 5-14-6 not later than November 1, 2019, containing the study
6	committee's findings and recommendations concerning, but not limited
7	to, the following:
8	(1) Creation of an "advanced practice pharmacist" designation.
9	(2) The qualifications and functions of an "advanced practice
0	pharmacist".
1	(3) Inclusion of pharmacists and "advanced practice pharmacists"
2	as providers in networks of insurers that issue policies of accident
3	and sickness insurance, as defined in IC 27-8-5-1.
