MADAM PRESIDENT:

I offer the following resolution and move its adoption:

1	A SENATE RESOLUTION honoring Marilyn Pfisterer
2	upon her retirement from the Indianapolis-Marion County
3	City-County Council.
4	Whereas, After 15 years of service on the Indianapolis-
5	Marion County City-County Council, Marilyn Pfisterer will
6	conclude her service at the end of April, 2019;
7	Whereas, Marilyn's interest in local government and
8	community issues began while living in Wayne Township on the
9	west side of Indianapolis;
0	Whereas, Marilyn worked on various campaigns for state
1	and local elected officials, served as Ward Chairman and
2	Precinct Committeewoman, and as Controller for the Secretary
3	of State before winning her first election to the Wayne
4	Township Board of Trustees in 1999;
5	Whereas, After continuously winning contested races for
6	the township board, Marilyn first ran for election to the
7	Indianapolis-Marion County City-County Council in 2003, and
8	she began her tenure on January 1, 2004;

1	Whereas, During her four terms on the City-County
2	Council, Marilyn desired to put the "service back into public
3	service", held regular town hall meetings, and corresponded
4	with constituents through e-newsletters, which helped Marilyn
5	keep her finger on the pulse of the needs and wants of Wayne
6	Township and Marion County;
7	Whereas, A strong advocate for public safety and law
8	enforcement personnel, Marilyn served on the Public Safety
9	and Criminal Justice Committee, and because of her
10	background in finance, Marilyn served on the Administration
11	and Finance Committee, serving for a time as Chair of the
12	Committee;
13	Whereas, Additionally, Marilyn served for a time as Vice
14	President of the City-County Council, and has served on
15	various commissions and boards throughout her tenure;
16	Whereas, In her limited free time, Marilyn volunteers as a
17	court-appointed child advocate, coordinates an annual job fair,
18	mentors students in the Wayne Township Schools, is actively
19	involved in the formation and development of the Indy
20	Gateway, and is actively involved in her church, the Speedway
21	Lion's Club, and West Side Chamber of Commerce Board; and
22	Whereas, After serving her community with distinction for
23	many years, upon retirement Marilyn will have more time to
24	spend with her three children, five grandchildren, and two
25	great-grandchildren: Therefore,
26	Be it resolved by the Senate of the
27	General Assembly of the State of Indiana:
28	SECTION 1. That the Indiana Senate honors Marilyn Pfisterer
29	upon her retirement from the Indianapolis-Marion County City-County
30	Council.
