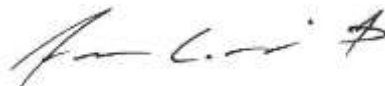
SUBJECT: Fiscal Note for SB 188 by Senator Haley

In accordance with KSA 75-3715a, the following fiscal note concerning SB 188 is respectfully submitted to your committee.

SB 188 would enact the Interstate Compact on the Agreement Among the States to Elect the President by National Popular Vote. Among other provisions, the bill would establish the requirements for membership in the Compact, the right of the people in the member states to vote for the President and Vice-President, the manner of appointing Presidential electors in member states, and define terms used in the bill. The bill would amend existing law concerning the convening and duties of the electors and require the electors of the President and Vice-President to vote according to the presidential slate receiving the largest national popular vote total.

According to the Secretary of State, enactment of SB 188 would have no effect on the agency's expenditures or revenues. The cost of any necessary updates to materials provided to the general public could be paid for from existing resources. According to the Kansas Association of Counties, enactment of HB 188 would have no fiscal effect on local administration of elections.
