Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:	

AN ACT concerning business entities: relating to use of names

Section 1. (a) If a business entity acquires another business entity, or acquires any right or interest in another business entity, the acquiring business entity shall not use the name of the acquired business entity, unless the acquiring business entity assumed responsibility for the acquired business entity's liabilities, including any warranties.

- (b) As used in this section, "business entity" means a corporation, limited liability company, partnership, association, sole proprietorship or any other business concern.
- Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
