AN ACT concerning the Kansas standard asset forfeiture act; relating to 1 2 offenses giving rise to forfeiture; amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 60-4104 3 and repealing the existing section. 4 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas: 6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby amended to read as 7 follows: 60-4104. Conduct and offenses giving rise to forfeiture under this act, whether or not there is a prosecution or only after a conviction related 8 9 to the offense, are: 10 (a) All offenses which statutorily and specifically authorize forfeiture; 11 (b) violations involving controlled substances, as described in K.S.A. 12 2016 Supp. 21-5701 through 21-5717, and amendments thereto; 13 (c) theft, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5801, and amendments 14 thereto: 15 (d) criminal discharge of a firearm, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-6308(a)(1) and (a)(2), and amendments thereto; 16 (e) gambling, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-6404, and 17 18 amendments thereto, and commercial gambling, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 19 Supp. 21-6406(a)(1), and amendments thereto; 20 (f) counterfeiting, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5825, and 21 amendments thereto; 22 (g) unlawful possession or use of a scanning device or reencoder, as 23 described in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-6108, and amendments thereto; 24 (h) medicaid fraud, as described in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5925 25 through 21-5934, and amendments thereto; 26 (i) an act or omission occurring outside this state, which would be a 27 violation in the place of occurrence and would be described in this section 28 if the act occurred in this state, whether or not it is prosecuted in any state; 29 (i) an act or omission committed in furtherance of any act or omission 30 described in this section including any inchoate or preparatory offense-31 whether or not there is a prosecution or conviction related to the act or 32 omission: 33 (k) any solicitation or conspiracy to commit any act or omission 34 described in this section, whether or not there is a prosecution or-35 conviction related to the act or omission; (1) terrorism, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 21-5421, and 36

(p) human trafficking and aggravated human trafficking, as defined in

(r) mistreatment of a dependent adult, as defined in K.S.A. 2016
Supp. 21-5417, and amendments thereto;

(s) giving a worthless check, as defined in K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 215821, and amendments thereto;

43 (cc) indecent solicitation of a child and aggravated indecent

 - Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 60-4104 is hereby repealed.
