

**HOUSE BILL No. 2070**

1 AN ACT designating a portion of United States highway 75 as the John  
2 Armstrong memorial highway; amending K.S.A. 68-1051 and  
3 repealing the existing section.  
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. The portion of United States highway 75 from the  
7 junction of United States highway 75 and N.W. 46<sup>th</sup> street in Shawnee  
8 county, then south on United States highway 75 to the junction of United  
9 States highway 75 and interstate highway 70 is hereby designated as the  
10 John Armstrong memorial highway. Upon compliance with K.S.A. 2018  
11 Supp. 68-10,114, and amendments thereto, the secretary of transportation  
12 shall place highway signs along the highway right-of-way at proper  
13 intervals to indicate that the highway is the John Armstrong memorial  
14 highway.

15 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-1051 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-  
16 1051. The portion of United States highway 75 where it enters the state on  
17 the Kansas-Nebraska border on the north then south to the junction with  
18 K-9, then south from the junction of K-9 with K-62 to the junction of K-62  
19 with K-16 then east to the junction with United States highway 75 then  
20 south on United States highway 75 to the southern city limits of Holton,  
21 then from the junction of United States highway 75 and N.W. 46<sup>th</sup> street  
22 and interstate highway 70 in Shawnee county then south on United States  
23 highway 75 to the southern boundary of Osage county, then from the  
24 northern city limits of the city of Yates Center south on United States  
25 highway 75 to the northern interchange with United States highway 400,  
26 then south from the southern interchange with United States highway 400  
27 to the Kansas-Oklahoma border, is hereby designated the purple  
28 heart/combat wounded veterans highway. The secretary of transportation  
29 shall place markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to  
30 indicate that the highway is the purple heart/combat wounded veterans  
31 highway. The secretary of transportation may accept and administer gifts  
32 and donations to aid in obtaining suitable highway signs bearing the proper  
33 approved inscription.

34 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-1051 is hereby repealed.

35 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
36 publication in the statute book.
