AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to supplemental general
 state aid; relating to consolidated or disorganized school districts;
 amending K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6434b and repealing the existing
 section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

K.S.A. 2010 Supp. 72-6434b is hereby amended to read 7 Section 1. as follows: 72-6434b. (a) Unless the context otherwise requires, as used 8 in this section, "district" means: (1) Any school district formed by 9 10 consolidation in accordance with article 87 of chapter 72 of the Kansas 11 Statutes Annotated; or (2) any school district formed by disorganization and attachment in accordance with article 73 of chapter 72 of the Kansas 12 13 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, if all the territory which 14 comprised a disorganized district is attached to a single district.

(b) (1) For the purposes of determining the amount of supplemental general state aid, the state board shall determine the ranking of each of the former school districts of which the district is composed as required by subsection (a)(2) of K.S.A. 72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year prior to the effectuation of the consolidation or attachment.

20 (2) For the school year in which the consolidation or attachment is 21 effectuated and the next succeeding two school years The provisions of 22 this paragraph shall apply to any consolidation of school districts completed prior to July 1, 2011. If any of the former school districts had 23 24 an enrollment of less than 150 pupils on September 20 of the school year 25 preceding the consolidation, the ranking of the district for the purposes of 26 subsection (a)(2) of K.S.A. 72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year in which the consolidation or attachment is effectuated and 27 the next two succeeding school years, shall be the ranking of the district 28 receiving the highest amount of supplemental general state aid 29 30 determined under paragraph (1).

(3) The provisions of this paragraph shall apply to any
consolidation of school districts completed on or after July 1, 2011. If
any of the former school districts had an enrollment of less than 150
pupils on September 20 of the school year preceding the consolidation,
the ranking of the district for the purposes of subsection (a)(2) of K.S.A.
72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year in which the

1 consolidation or attachment is effectuated and the next succeeding school

2 *year, shall be the ranking of the district receiving the highest amount of* 3 *supplemental general state aid determined under paragraph (1).*

(4) If all of the former school districts had an enrollment of at least 4 150 pupils, but any had less than 200 pupils on September 20 of the 5 school year preceding the consolidation, the ranking of the district for 6 7 the purposes of subsection (a)(2) of K.S.A. 72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year in which the consolidation or attachment is 8 effectuated and the next three succeeding school years, shall be the 9 ranking of the district receiving the highest amount of supplemental 10 general state aid determined under paragraph (1). 11

12 (5) If all of the former school districts had an enrollment of at least 200 pupils on September 20 of the school year preceding the 13 consolidation, the ranking of the district for the purposes of subsection 14 (a)(2) of K.S.A. 72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year in 15 which the consolidation or attachment is effectuated and the next four 16 succeeding school years, shall be the ranking of the district receiving the 17 18 highest amount of supplemental general state aid determined under 19 paragraph (1).

20 (6) If the consolidation involved the consolidation of three or more school districts, regardless of the number of pupils enrolled in such 21 districts, the ranking of the district for the purposes of subsection (a)(2)22 of K.S.A. 72-6434, and amendments thereto, for the school year in which 23 the consolidation or attachment is effectuated and the next four 24 succeeding school years, shall be the ranking of the district receiving the 25 highest amount of supplemental general state aid determined under 26 27 paragraph (1).

(c) The provisions of this section shall apply to districts which have
 consolidated or disorganized on and after July 1, 2004 2008.
