AN ACT concerning school districts; relating to the local boards of education of school districts; authorizing school districts to compensate members of local boards of education for the work and duties performed by such board members; amending K.S.A. 72-1137 and repealing the existing section.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 72-1137 is hereby amended to read as follows: 72-1137. In addition to the officers provided for in this act, the board of education of any school district may appoint other officers and employees to serve at the pleasure of the board. Such officers and employees shall receive compensation fixed by the board. No member of a board of education shall receive compensation from the school district for any work or duties performed by him. Members of a board of education of a school district may receive compensation from the school district for the work and duties performed by such board members.

- Sec. 2. K.S.A. 72-1137 is hereby repealed.
- Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the statute book.
