1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to registration fees; electric
2 and hybrid vehicles; amending K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-143 and repealing
3 the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2018 Supp. 8-143 is hereby amended to read as
7 follows: 8-143. (a) All applications for the registration of motorcycles,
8 motorized bicycles and passenger vehicles other than trucks and truck
9 tractors, except as otherwise provided, shall be accompanied by an annual
10 license fee as follows:

11 (1) *Prior to January 1, 2020:*

12 (A) For motorized bicycles, \$11;

13 ~~(B)~~(B) for motorcycles, \$16;

14 ~~(C)~~(C) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for
15 the carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and
16 ambulances a fee of:

17 ~~(A)~~(i) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, \$30;
18 and

19 ~~(B)~~(ii) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds,
20 \$40.

21 ~~(D)~~(D) Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered
22 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the
23 annual registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer owned
24 by any political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency or
25 instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of this
26 state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any
27 private or utility purposes, ~~which~~ that is not otherwise exempt from
28 registration, shall be \$2.

29 (2) *On and after January 1, 2020:*

30 (A) For motorized bicycles, \$11;

31 (B) for motorcycles, \$16;

32 (C) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for
33 the carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and
34 ambulances a fee of:

35 (i) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, \$30;

36 (ii) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds, \$40;

1 ~~(iii) for those motor vehicles propelled by more than one power-~~
2 ~~source mated together to work in conjunction each plug-in hybrid~~
3 ~~electric vehicle, \$75; and~~

4 (iv) ~~for each electric vehicle~~ **that is an all-electric plug-in vehicle,**
5 **\$150.**

6 (D) *Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered*
7 *under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the*
8 *annual registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer*
9 *owned by any political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency*
10 *or instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of*
11 *this state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any*
12 *private or utility purposes, that is not otherwise exempt from registration,*
13 *shall be \$2.*

14 (b) (1) As used in this subsection, the term "gross weight" shall mean
15 and include the empty weight of the truck, or combination of the truck or
16 truck tractor and any type trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight
17 of cargo which will be transported on or with the same, except when the
18 empty weight of a truck plus the maximum weight of cargo which will be
19 transported thereon is 12,000 pounds or less. The term gross weight shall
20 not include: The weight of any travel trailer propelled thereby which is
21 being used for private recreational purposes; or the weight of any vehicle
22 or combination of vehicles for which wrecker or towing service, as defined
23 in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments thereto, is to be provided by a
24 wrecker or tow truck, as defined in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments
25 thereto. Such wrecker or tow truck shall be registered for the empty weight
26 of such vehicle fully equipped for the recovery or towing of vehicles. The
27 gross weight license fees hereinafter prescribed shall only apply to the
28 truck or truck tractor used as the propelling unit for the cargo and vehicle
29 propelled, either as a single vehicle or combination of vehicles. On
30 application for the registration of a truck or truck tractor, the owner thereof
31 shall declare as a part of such application the maximum gross weight the
32 owner desires to be applicable to such vehicle, which declared gross
33 weight in no event shall be in excess of the limitations described by K.S.A.
34 8-1908 and 8-1909, and amendments thereto, for such vehicle or
35 combination of vehicles of which it will be a part. All applications for the
36 registration of trucks or truck tractors, except as otherwise provided
37 herein, shall be accompanied by an annual license fee as follows:

42	(2) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a	
43	gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds is in the state of Kansas or any	

1 political or taxing subdivision or agency of the state, except a city or
2 county, whose truck or truck tractor is not otherwise entitled to the \$2
3 license fee or otherwise exempt from all fees, such vehicle may be
4 licensed for a fee in accordance with the schedule hereinafter prescribed
5 for local trucks or truck tractors.

6 (3) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a
7 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds shall under oath state in writing
8 on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles that the
9 applicant does not expect to operate it more than 6,000 miles in the
10 calendar year for which the applicant seeks registration, and that if the
11 applicant shall operate it more than 6,000 miles during such registration
12 year such applicant will pay an additional fee equal to the fee required by
13 the schedule under paragraph (1), less the amount of the fee paid at time of
14 registration, such vehicle may be licensed for a fee in accordance with the
15 schedule prescribed for local trucks or truck tractors. Whenever a truck or
16 truck tractor is registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis a tab or
17 marker shall be issued in connection with the regular license plate, which
18 tab or marker shall be attached or affixed to and displayed with the regular
19 license plate and the failure to have the same attached, affixed or displayed
20 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided by law for the failure to
21 display the regular license plate; and the secretary of revenue may adopt
22 rules and regulations requiring the owners of trucks and truck tractors so
23 registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis to keep such records
24 and make such reports of mileage of such vehicles as the secretary of
25 revenue shall deem proper.

26 (4) A transporter delivering vehicles not the transporter's own by the
27 driveaway method where such vehicles are being driven, towed, or
28 transported singly, or by the saddlemount, towbar, or fullmount methods,
29 or by any lawful combination thereof, may apply for license plates which
30 may be transferred from one such vehicle or combination to another for
31 each delivery without further registration, and the annual license fee for
32 such license plate shall be as follows:

42 (5) A truck or truck tractor registered for a gross weight of more than
43 12,000 pounds, ~~which~~ *that* is operated wholly within the corporate limits

1 of a city or village or within a radius of 25 miles beyond the corporate
 2 limits, shall be classified as a local truck except that in no event shall such
 3 vehicles operated as contract or common carriers outside a radius of three
 4 miles beyond the corporate limits of the city or village in which such
 5 vehicles were based when registered and licensed be considered local
 6 trucks or truck tractors. The secretary of revenue is hereby authorized and
 7 directed to adopt rules and regulations prescribing a procedure for the
 8 issuance of permits by the division of vehicles whereby owners of local
 9 trucks or truck tractors may operate any such vehicle, empty, beyond the
 10 radius hereinbefore prescribed, when such operation is solely for the
 11 purpose of having such vehicle repaired, painted or serviced or for adding
 12 additional equipment thereto. The annual license fee for a local truck or
 13 truck tractor, except as otherwise provided herein, shall be as follows:

33 A vehicle licensed as a farm truck or truck tractor may be used by the

34 owner thereof to transport, for charity and without compensation of any

35 kind, commodities for religious or educational institutions. A truck ~~which~~

36 *that* is licensed as a farm truck may also be used for the transportation of

37 sand, gravel, slag stone, limestone, crushed stone, cinders, black top, dirt

38 or fill material to a township road maintenance or construction site of the

39 township in which the owner of such truck resides. Any applicant for

40 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used in combination

41 with a trailer or semitrailer shall register the farm truck or farm truck

42 tractor for a gross weight which shall include the empty weight of the

43 truck or truck tractor or of the combination of any truck or truck tractor

1 and any type of trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight of cargo
 2 ~~which that~~ will be transported on or with the same. The applicant for
 3 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used to transport a
 4 gross weight of more than 54,000 pounds shall durably letter on the side of
 5 the motor vehicle the words "farm vehicle—not for hire." If an applicant
 6 for registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor operates such
 7 vehicle for any use or purpose not authorized for a farm truck or farm
 8 truck tractor, such applicant shall pay an additional fee equal to the fee
 9 required for the registration of all trucks or truck tractors not registered as
 10 local, 6,000-mile or farm truck or farm truck tractor motor vehicles, less
 11 the amount of the fee paid at time of registration. Nothing in this or the
 12 preceding paragraph shall authorize a gross weight of a vehicle or
 13 combination of vehicles on the national system of interstate and defense
 14 highways greater than permitted by laws of the United States congress.

15 (7) Except as hereinafter provided, the annual license fee for each
 16 local urban transit bus used in local urban transit operations exempted
 17 under the provisions of ~~subsection (a) of K.S.A. 66-1,109(a), and~~
 18 amendments thereto, shall be based on the passenger seating capacity of
 19 the bus and shall be as follows:

36 (8) For licensing purposes, station wagons with a carrying capacity of
 37 less than 10 passengers shall be subject to registration fees based on the
 38 weight of the vehicles, as provided in subsection (a). Station wagons with
 39 a carrying capacity of 10 or more passengers shall be subject to the truck
 40 classifications and license fees as provided.

41 (9) For any trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer or pole trailer the annual
 42 license fee shall be as follows:

43 ~~(A) (i) Until January 1, 2013, for any such vehicle with a gross~~

1 weight of more than 12,000 pounds the annual fee shall be \$35;

2 (ii) ~~on January 1, 2013,~~ For any such vehicle with a gross weight of
3 more than 12,000 pounds but less than 54,000 pounds the annual fee shall
4 be ~~\$45, on January 1, 2014,~~ \$55;

5 (B) any such vehicle grossing more than 8,000 pounds but not over

11 Any such vehicle having a gross weight of 2,000 pounds or less may, at
12 the owner's option, be registered and the fee for such registration shall be
13 as provided in paragraph (C).

14 Any trailer, semitrailer or travel trailer owned by a nonresident of this
15 state and based in another state, ~~which~~ *that* is properly registered and
16 licensed in the state of residence of the owner or in the state where based,
17 may be operated in this state without being registered or licensed in this
18 state if the truck or truck tractor propelling the same is properly registered
19 and licensed in this state, or is registered and licensed in some other state
20 and is entitled to reciprocal privileges of operation in this state, but this
21 provision shall not apply to any trailer or semitrailer owned by a
22 nonresident of this state when such trailer or semitrailer is owned by a
23 person who has proportionately registered and licensed a fleet of vehicles
24 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 ~~to~~ *through* 8-1,123, ~~inclusive,~~ and
25 amendments thereto, or under the terms of any reciprocal or proration
26 agreement made pursuant thereto.

27 At the option of the owner, any trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer, with a
28 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds, may be issued a multi-year
29 registration for a five-year period upon payment of the appropriate
30 registration fee. The fee for a five-year registration of such trailer shall be
31 five times the annual fee for such trailer. If the annual registration fee is
32 increased during the multi-year registration period, the owner of the trailer
33 with such multi-year registration shall be subject to the amount of the
34 increase of the annual registration fee for the remaining calendar years of
35 such multi-year registration. When the owner of any trailer, semitrailer or
36 pole trailer registered under this multi-year provision transfers or assigns
37 the title, or interest thereto, the registration of such trailer shall expire. The
38 owner shall remove the license plate from such trailer and forward the
39 license plate to the division of vehicles or may have such license plate
40 assigned to another trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer upon the payment of
41 fees required by law. Any owner of a trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer
42 where the multi-year registration fee has been paid and the trailer is sold,
43 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by

1 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
2 to another trailer, may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
3 remaining calendar years by making application to the division of vehicles
4 on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of vehicles. The
5 secretary of revenue may adopt such rules and regulations necessary to
6 implement the multi-year registration of such trailers, semitrailers and pole
7 trailers.

8 (c) Any truck or truck tractor having a gross weight of 4,000 pounds
9 or over, using solid tires, shall pay a license fee of double the amount
10 herein charged. The annual fees herein provided for trucks, truck tractors
11 and trailers not subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, shall be
12 due January 1 of each year and payable on or before the last day of
13 February in each year. If the fee is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1
14 shall be added to the fee charged herein for each month or fraction thereof
15 and until December 31 of each registration year. The annual registration
16 fee for all passenger vehicles and vehicles subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and
17 amendments thereto, shall be due on or before the last day of the month in
18 which the registration plate expires and shall be due for other vehicles as
19 provided by K.S.A. 8-134, and amendments thereto. If the registration fee
20 is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1 shall be added to the fee charged
21 herein for each month or fraction thereof until such registration fee is paid.
22 Members of the armed forces of the United States shall be permitted to
23 apply for registration at any time and be subject to registration fee, less
24 penalties, applicable at the time the application is made. If any motorcycle,
25 motorized bicycle, trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, or pole trailer is either
26 purchased or acquired after the anniversary or renewal date in any
27 registration year there shall immediately become due and payable a
28 registration fee as follows: If purchased or acquired between the
29 anniversary or renewal date of any registration year and the first six
30 months of such registration year, the annual fee hereinbefore provided; if
31 purchased or acquired during the last six months of any registration year,
32 50% of such annual fee. If any truck or truck tractor, except trucks subject
33 to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, is purchased or acquired prior
34 to April 1 of any year the fee shall be the annual fee hereinbefore provided,
35 but if such truck or truck tractor is purchased or acquired after the end of
36 March of any year, the license fee for such year shall be reduced $\frac{1}{12}$
37 for each calendar month which has elapsed since the beginning of the year. If
38 any truck registered for a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less or
39 passenger vehicle is purchased or acquired and less than 12 months remain
40 in the registration period, the fee shall be $\frac{1}{12}$ of the annual fee for each
41 calendar month remaining in the registration period.

42 (d) The owner of any motorcycle, motorized bicycle, passenger
43 vehicle, truck, truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, or electrically propelled

1 vehicle who fails to pay the registration fee or fees herein provided on the
2 date when the same become due and payable shall be guilty of a
3 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a penalty in
4 the sum of \$1 for each month or fraction thereof during which such fee has
5 remained unpaid after it became due and payable; and in addition thereto
6 shall be subject to such other punishment as is provided in this act. Upon
7 the transfer of motorcycles, motorized bicycles, passenger vehicles,
8 trailers, semitrailers, trucks or truck tractors, on which registration fees
9 have been paid for the year in which the transfer is made, either: (1) To a
10 corporation by one or more persons, solely in exchange for stock or
11 securities in such corporation; or (2) by one corporation to another
12 corporation when all of the assets of such corporation are transferred to the
13 other corporation, then in either case, *paragraph* (1) or—*ease* (2) the
14 corporation shall be exempt from the payment of registration fees on such
15 vehicles for the year in which such transfer is made. Applications for
16 transfer or registration shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.50. When the
17 registration of a vehicle has expired at midnight on the last day of any
18 registration year, and such vehicle is not thereafter operated upon the
19 highways, any application for renewal of registration made subsequent to
20 the anniversary or renewal date of any registration year following the
21 expiration of such registration and for succeeding registration years in
22 which such vehicle has not been registered shall be accompanied by an
23 affidavit of nonoperation and nonuse, and such application for renewal or
24 registration shall be received by the division of vehicles upon payment of
25 the proper fees for the current registration year and without penalty.

26 (e) Any nonresident of Kansas purchasing a vehicle from a Kansas
27 resident and desiring to secure registration on the vehicle in the state of
28 such person's residence may make application in the office of any county
29 treasurer for a sixty-day temporary registration. The county treasurer upon
30 presentation of evidence of ownership in the applicant and evidence the
31 sales tax has been paid, if due, shall charge and collect a fee of \$3 for each
32 sixty-day temporary license and issue a sticker or paper registration as may
33 be determined by the director of vehicles, and the registration so issued
34 shall be valid for a period of 60 days from the date of issuance.

35 (f) Any owner of any motor vehicle ~~which~~ *that* is subject to taxation
36 under the provisions of article 51 of chapter 79 of the Kansas Statutes
37 Annotated, and amendments thereto, or any other truck or truck tractor
38 where the annual registration fee has been paid and the vehicle is sold,
39 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by
40 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
41 to another vehicle may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
42 remaining portion of the year by making application to the division of
43 vehicles on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of

1 vehicles, accompanied by all license plates and attachments issued in
2 connection therewith. If the owner of the registration becomes deceased
3 and the vehicle is not going to be used on the highway, and title is not
4 being currently transferred, the proper representative of the estate shall be
5 entitled to the refund. The refund shall be made only for the period of time
6 remaining in the registration year from the date of completion and filing of
7 the application with and delivery of the license plate and attachments to
8 the division of vehicles. Where the registration is secured under a quarterly
9 payment annual registration fee, as provided for in K.S.A. 8-143a, and
10 amendments thereto, such refund shall be made on the quarterly fee paid
11 and unused and all remaining quarterly payments shall be canceled. Any
12 truck or truck tractor having the registration fee paid on quarterly payment
13 basis, all quarterly payments due or a fraction of quarterly payment due
14 shall be paid before title may be transferred, except that in case of death,
15 the filing of the application and returning of the license plate and
16 attachment shall cancel the remaining annual payments due. Whenever a
17 truck or truck tractor, where the registration is secured on a quarterly
18 payment of the annual registration, the one repossessing the truck or truck
19 tractor, or foreclosing by a mechanic's lien, or securing title by court order,
20 the mortgagor or the assigns of the mortgagor, or the one securing title
21 may pay the balance due on date of application for title, but the payments
22 for the remaining portion of the year shall not be canceled unless
23 application is made and the license plate and attachments are surrendered.
24 Nothing in this subsection shall apply when registration is secured under
25 the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 ~~to through~~ 8-1,123, ~~inclusive~~, and
26 amendments thereto. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions of
27 this section, no refund shall be made under the provisions of this section
28 where the amount thereof does not exceed \$5. The division of vehicles
29 shall furnish such blank forms as may be required under the provisions of
30 this subsection as it deems necessary to be completed by the applicant.
31 Whenever a registration which has been secured on a quarterly basis shall
32 be canceled as provided in this subsection, the division of vehicles shall
33 notify the county treasurer issuing the original registration of such
34 cancellation so that the county treasurer may, and the county treasurer shall
35 cancel the registration of such vehicle in the county treasurer's office and
36 release any lien issued in connection with such registration.

37 (g) Every owner of a travel trailer designed for or intended to be
38 moved upon any highway in this state shall, before the same is so moved,
39 apply for and obtain the proper registration thereof as provided in this act,
40 except when such unit is permitted to be moved under the special
41 provisions relating to secured parties, manufacturers, dealers and
42 nonresidents contained in this act. At the time of registering any travel
43 trailer for the purpose of moving any such vehicle upon any highway in

1 this state, the owner thereof shall indicate on the registration form whether
2 or not such vehicle is being moved permanently to a location outside of the
3 county in which such vehicle is being registered. No such vehicle which
4 the owner thereof intends to move to a permanent location outside the
5 boundaries of such county shall be registered for movement on the
6 highways of this state until all taxes levied against such vehicle have been
7 paid. A copy of such registration form shall be sent to the county clerk or
8 assessor of the county to which such vehicle is being moved. When such
9 travel trailer is used for living quarters and not operated on the highways,
10 the owner shall be exempt from the license fees as provided in subsection
11 (b)(9) so long as such travel trailer is not operated on the highway.
