

**HOUSE BILL No. 2429**

1 AN ACT concerning the Kansas cigarette and tobacco products act;  
2 relating to distribution of tax revenues, children's initiatives fund;  
3 amending K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 79-3387 and repealing the existing  
4 section.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 79-3387 is hereby amended to read as  
8 follows: 79-3387. (a) *Except as otherwise provided in subsection (c)*, all  
9 revenue collected or received by the director from taxes imposed by this  
10 act shall be remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the  
11 provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of  
12 each such remittance, the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in  
13 the state treasury to the credit of the state general fund.

14 (b) All moneys received from license fees imposed by this act shall  
15 be collected by the director and shall be remitted to the state treasurer in  
16 accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments  
17 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall  
18 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the cigarette  
19 and tobacco products regulation fund created by K.S.A. 79-3391, and  
20 amendments thereto.

21 (c) *On and after July 1, 2017, and each July 1 thereafter, the state*  
22 *treasurer shall deposit and credit the first \$35,000,000 of revenue*  
23 *collected or received by the director from taxes imposed by this act to the*  
24 *children's initiatives fund established by K.S.A. 38-2102, and amendments*  
25 *thereto. The state treasurer shall deposit and credit the remaining balance*  
26 *to the credit of the state general fund.*

27 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2016 Supp. 79-3387 is hereby repealed.

28 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
29 publication in the statute book.
