1 AN ACT concerning wildlife; relating to hunting; establishing the Kansas
2 kids lifetime combination hunting and fishing license; **requiring an**
3 **annual report from the secretary of wildlife and parks to certain**
4 **legislative committees on the number of such licenses issued.**

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. (a) The secretary of wildlife and parks is authorized to
8 issue a Kansas kids lifetime combination hunting and fishing license to
9 any child who is five years of age or younger and is a resident, as defined
10 in K.S.A. 32-701, and amendments thereto, upon payment of a license fee
11 that shall not exceed ~~\$200~~ **{ \$300 }** and that may be paid on behalf of such
12 child. **{ On and after July 1, 2027, and upon approval from the Kansas**
13 **wildlife and parks commission, such license fee shall not exceed \$400. }**

14 (b) **The secretary of wildlife and parks shall report annually to**
15 **the house of representatives agriculture and natural resources budget**
16 **committee, or the successor of such committee, on the number of such**
17 **Kansas kids lifetime combination hunting and fishing licenses issued**
18 **by the Kansas department of wildlife and parks.**

19 **{(c) The provisions of this section shall expire on July 1, 2032.}**

20 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
21 publication in the statute book.
