1 AN ACT concerning roads and highways; designating a portion of United
2 States highway 73 as the Col Chuck Rambo memorial highway;
3 amending K.S.A. 68-1034 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. The portion of United States highway 73 from its
7 northern junction with K-92 highway in Leavenworth county, then north to
8 the eastern junction with United States highway 59 in the city of Atchison
9 is hereby designated as the Col Chuck Rambo memorial highway. Upon
10 compliance with K.S.A. 68-10,114, and amendments thereto, the secretary
11 of transportation shall place suitable signs to indicate that the highway is
12 the Col Chuck Rambo memorial highway.

13 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-
14 1034. From the junction of United States highway 24 and United States
15 highway 40 with United States highway 73 and highway K-7, United
16 States highway 73 and highway K-7 north to the southern city limits of
17 Lansing, then north from the northern city limits of Lansing to the
18 *northern junction of United States highway 73 with K-92 highway in*
19 *Leavenworth county, then west on United States highway 73 from the*
20 *eastern junction of United States highway 73 with United States highway*
21 *59 in the city of Atchison, ~~United States highway 73 west~~ to the junction*
22 *with United States highway 159, is hereby designated as the Amelia*
23 *Earhart memorial highway. The secretary of transportation shall place*
24 *markers along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that*
25 *the highway is the Amelia Earhart memorial highway. The secretary of*
26 *transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in*
27 *obtaining suitable highway signs bearing the proper approved inscription.*

28 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-1034 is hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
30 publication in the statute book.
