

## HOUSE BILL No. 2566

1 AN ACT designating a portion of interstate highway 70 as the Kylie Jobe  
2 and Kyle Thornburg memorial highway; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp.  
3 68-1091 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. The portion of interstate highway 70 from mile  
7 marker 209, then east to mile marker 213 is hereby designated as the Kylie  
8 Jobe and Kyle Thornburg memorial highway. Upon compliance with  
9 K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 68-10,114, and amendments thereto, the secretary of  
10 transportation shall place highway signs along the highway right-of-way at  
11 proper intervals to indicate that the highway is the Kylie Jobe and Kyle  
12 Thornburg memorial highway.

13 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 68-1091 is hereby amended to read as  
14 follows: 68-1091. If the state of Missouri designates a portion of interstate  
15 highway 70 as the Truman/Eisenhower Presidential highway, or something  
16 substantially similar, then the portion of interstate highway 70 from the  
17 Missouri state line *west to mile marker 213 and from mile marker 209*  
18 *west* to the junction with highway K-15 shall be designated the  
19 Eisenhower/Truman Presidential highway. The secretary of transportation  
20 shall place signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to  
21 indicate that the highway is the Eisenhower/Truman Presidential highway,  
22 except that such signs shall not be placed until the secretary has received  
23 sufficient moneys from gifts and donations to reimburse the secretary for  
24 the cost of placing such signs and an additional 50% of the cost to defray  
25 future maintenance or replacement costs of such signs. The secretary of  
26 transportation may accept and administer gifts and donations to aid in  
27 obtaining and installing suitable signs.

28 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 68-1091 is hereby repealed.

29 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
30 publication in the statute book.
