1 AN ACT concerning children and minors; relating to children with 2 problem sexual behavior; department for children and families.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

5 Section 1. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of law, if the 6 department for children and families receives a report of child abuse or 7 neglect and the subject of the report is a child with problem sexual 8 behavior, the department shall immediately:

9 (1) Assess any service needs of the family of such child based on 10 information gathered from the family and other sources;

11 (2) provide services that are voluntary, unless the department 12 determines there will be a high risk of abuse or neglect if the family 13 refuses to accept such services. The department shall identify services for families if the department determines the child is at high risk of future 14 abuse or neglect. The department shall thoroughly document in the record 15 16 its attempt to provide voluntary services and the reasons these services are important to reduce the risk of future abuse or neglect of the child. If the 17 18 family continues to refuse voluntary services or the child needs to be 19 protected, the department may commence an investigation; and

20 (3) document, at the time the case is closed, the outcome for the 21 family, any service provided and the removal of risk to the child, if it 22 existed.

(b) As used in this section, "child with problem sexual behavior"
means a child under 14 years of age who has allegedly committed sexual
abuse against another child.

(c) Nothing in this section shall prohibit any other investigation oraction by the department that is otherwise authorized by law.
