

## HOUSE BILL No. 2613

By Committee on Education

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1 AN ACT concerning education; relating to the provision of assistive  
2 technology, sign language and Braille services; amending K.S.A. 2017  
3 Supp. 72-3462 and repealing the existing section.  
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5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 72-3462 is hereby amended to read as  
7 follows: 72-3462. (a) Every school district shall provide special education  
8 services for exceptional children who reside in the school district and  
9 attend a private, nonprofit elementary or secondary school, whether such  
10 school is located within or outside the school district, upon request of a  
11 parent or guardian of any such child for the provision of such services. No  
12 school district shall be required to provide such services outside the school  
13 district. ~~Any~~ Every school district ~~may~~ shall provide special education  
14 services for exceptional children who attend a private, nonprofit  
15 elementary or secondary school located within the school district, whether  
16 or not all such children reside in the school district.

17 (b) Special education services which are provided under this section  
18 for exceptional children who attend a private, nonprofit elementary or  
19 secondary school ~~which~~ that is located in the school district may be  
20 provided in the private, nonprofit elementary or secondary school or in the  
21 public schools of the school district. The site for the provision of special  
22 education services under this section for an exceptional child shall be  
23 determined by the school district in consultation with the parent or  
24 guardian of the child and with officials of the private, nonprofit elementary  
25 or secondary school, *except that the provision of assistive technology, sign*  
26 *language interpreting services or Braille materials shall be provided at*  
27 *the private, nonprofit elementary or secondary school where the*  
28 *exceptional child attends in order to make accessible or to translate the*  
29 *classroom discussion and curriculum of the private, nonprofit elementary*  
30 *or secondary school. During a consultation between the school district*  
31 *and the parent or guardian, the school district shall provide*  
32 *documentation demonstrating how the average cost, if any, and the actual*  
33 *cost to the school district for the provision of special education services in*  
34 *the public schools of the school district for children within the same*  
35 *category of exceptionality is calculated.*

36 (c) Special education services provided under this section for

1 exceptional children who attend a private, nonprofit elementary or  
2 secondary school are subject to the following requirements: ~~(a)~~ (1) If the  
3 services are provided ~~for~~ in the private, nonprofit elementary or secondary  
4 school, amounts expended for the provision of such services shall not be  
5 required to exceed the average cost to the school district for the provision  
6 of the same services in the public schools of the school district for children  
7 within the same category of exceptionality, *except if the average cost of*  
8 *such services cannot be determined, then the amounts expended for the*  
9 *provision of such services shall not exceed the actual cost to the school*  
10 *district for the provision of the same services in the public schools of the*  
11 *school district for children within the same category of exceptionality; ~~(b)~~  
12 (2) if the services are provided ~~for~~ in the public schools of the school  
13 district, the services shall be provided on an equal basis with the provision  
14 of such services for exceptional children attending the public schools; and  
15 ~~(c)~~ (3) if the services are provided in the public schools of the school  
16 district, transportation to and from such public school shall be provided by  
17 the school district.*

18 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2017 Supp. 72-3462 is hereby repealed.
