Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. K.S.A. 40-908 is hereby amended to read as follows: 40-5 908. That In all actions now pending, or hereafter commenced in which 6 judgment is rendered against any insurance company on any-policy given 8 to insure any property in this state against loss by first-party policy claim 9 for damage to real property or contents of real property caused by loss from fire, tornado, lightning or hail, the court in rendering such judgment 10 11 shall allow the plaintiff a reasonable sum as an attorney's fee attorney fees 12 for services in such action including proceeding upon appeal to be 13 recovered and collected as a part of the costs: Provided, however, except 14 that when a tender is made by such insurance company before the commencement of the action in which judgment is rendered and the 15 amount recovered is not in excess of such tender no such costs shall be 16 17 allowed
