1 AN ACT concerning roads and highways; designating a portion of United  
2 States highway 77 as the Capt. Donald Root Strother memorial  
3 highway; amending K.S.A. 68-1010 and repealing the existing section.  
4

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 New Section 1. The portion of United States highway 77 from the  
7 junction of United States highway 77 and 212<sup>th</sup> road in Cowley county,  
8 then south on United States highway 77 to the junction of United States  
9 highway 77 and 22<sup>nd</sup> road is hereby designated as the Capt. Donald Root  
10 Strother memorial highway. Upon compliance with K.S.A. 68-10,114, and  
11 amendments thereto, the secretary of transportation shall place highway  
12 signs along the highway right-of-way at proper intervals to indicate that  
13 the highway is the Capt. Donald Root Strother memorial highway.

14 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 68-1010 is hereby amended to read as follows: 68-  
15 1010. The portion of United States highway 77 from the northern  
16 boundary of Cowley county *then south* to the junction with 212<sup>th</sup> road in  
17 Cowley county, *then south from the junction of United States highway 77*  
18 *and 22<sup>nd</sup> road on United States highway 77 to the northern junction with*  
19 *United States highway 77 business, then south*~~on~~ *from the southern*  
20 *junction of United States highway 77 business*~~to~~ *and United States*  
21 *highway 77*~~then south~~ *on United States highway 77 to the Kansas-*  
22 *Oklahoma border is hereby designated the Robert B. Docking memorial*  
23 *highway.*

24 Sec. 3. K.S.A. 68-1010 is hereby repealed.

25 Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its  
26 publication in the statute book.
