1 AN ACT concerning state finances; relating to drug rebate revenues
2 associated with medical assistance enrollees; requiring deposit thereof
3 into the state general fund; reporting thereof.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. (a) The department of health and environment shall remit
7 all moneys received by the department of health and environment from
8 drug rebates associated with medical assistance enrollees to the state
9 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
10 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
11 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount into the state treasury to the credit
12 of the state general fund.

13 (b) The department of health and environment shall certify the
14 amount of moneys received by such agency from drug rebates associated
15 with medical assistance enrollees on a monthly basis and shall transmit
16 each such certification to the director of legislative research and the
17 director of the budget.

18 (c) Upon receipt of each certification described in subsection (b), the
19 director of legislative research and the director of the budget shall include
20 such certified amount on any monthly report prepared by the legislative
21 research department or the division of the budget that details state general
22 fund receipts as a separate item entitled "drug rebates" under a category of
23 other revenue sources.

24 Sec. 2. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after July 1,
25 2022, and its publication in the statute book.
