1 AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to passenger vehicles;
2 registration fees, dedicating a portion to the law enforcement training
3 center fund; amending K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-143 and 8-145 and
4 repealing the existing sections.

6 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

7 Section 1. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-143 is hereby amended to read as
8 follows: 8-143. (a) All applications for the registration of motorcycles,
9 motorized bicycles and passenger vehicles other than trucks and truck
10 tractors, except as otherwise provided, shall be accompanied by an annual
11 license fee as follows:

12 (1) For motorized bicycles, \$11;

13 (2) for motorcycles, \$16;

14 (3) for passenger vehicles, other than motorcycles, used solely for the
15 carrying of persons for pleasure or business, and for hearses and
16 ambulances a fee of:

17 (A) For those having a gross weight of 4,500 pounds or less, ~~\$30~~ \$32;
18 and

19 (B) for those having a gross weight of more than 4,500 pounds, \$40.

20 (4) Except for motor vehicles, trailers or semitrailers registered under
21 the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,134, and amendments thereto, the annual
22 registration fee for each motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer owned by any
23 political or taxing subdivision of this state or by any agency or
24 instrumentality of any one or more political or taxing subdivisions of this
25 state and used exclusively for governmental purposes and not for any
26 private or utility purposes, which is not otherwise exempt from
27 registration, shall be \$2.

28 (b) (1) As used in this subsection, the term "gross weight" shall mean
29 and include the empty weight of the truck, or combination of the truck or
30 truck tractor and any type trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight
31 of cargo which will be transported on or with the same, except when the
32 empty weight of a truck plus the maximum weight of cargo which will be
33 transported thereon is 12,000 pounds or less. The term gross weight shall
34 not include: The weight of any travel trailer propelled thereby which is
35 being used for private recreational purposes; or the weight of any vehicle
36 or combination of vehicles for which wrecker or towing service, as defined

1 in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments thereto, is to be provided by a
 2 wrecker or tow truck, as defined in K.S.A. 66-1329, and amendments
 3 thereto. Such wrecker or tow truck shall be registered for the empty weight
 4 of such vehicle fully equipped for the recovery or towing of vehicles. The
 5 gross weight license fees hereinafter prescribed shall only apply to the
 6 truck or truck tractor used as the propelling unit for the cargo and vehicle
 7 propelled, either as a single vehicle or combination of vehicles. On
 8 application for the registration of a truck or truck tractor, the owner thereof
 9 shall declare as a part of such application the maximum gross weight the
 10 owner desires to be applicable to such vehicle, which declared gross
 11 weight in no event shall be in excess of the limitations described by K.S.A.
 12 8-1908 and 8-1909, and amendments thereto, for such vehicle or
 13 combination of vehicles of which it will be a part. All applications for the
 14 registration of trucks or truck tractors, except as otherwise provided
 15 herein, shall be accompanied by an annual license fee as follows:

20 (2) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a

21 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds is the state of Kansas or any

22 political or taxing subdivision or agency of the state, except a city or

23 county, whose truck or truck tractor is not otherwise entitled to the \$2

24 license fee or otherwise exempt from all fees, such vehicle may be

25 licensed for a fee in accordance with the schedule hereinafter prescribed

26 for local trucks or truck tractors.

27 (3) If the applicant for registration of any truck or truck tractor for a

28 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds shall under oath state in writing

29 on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles that the

30 applicant does not expect to operate it more than 6,000 miles in the

31 calendar year for which the applicant seeks registration, and that if the

32 applicant shall operate it more than 6,000 miles during such registration

33 year such applicant will pay an additional fee equal to the fee required by

34 the schedule under paragraph (1), less the amount of the fee paid at time of

35 registration, such vehicle may be licensed for a fee in accordance with the

36 schedule prescribed for local trucks or truck tractors. Whenever a truck or

37 truck tractor is registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis a tab or

38 marker shall be issued in connection with the regular license plate, which

39 tab or marker shall be attached or affixed to and displayed with the regular

40 license plate and the failure to have the same attached, affixed or displayed

41 shall be subject to the same penalties as provided by law for the failure to

42 display the regular license plate; and the secretary of revenue may adopt

43 rules and regulations requiring the owners of trucks and truck tractors so

1 registered on a local truck or truck tractor fee basis to keep such records
 2 and make such reports of mileage of such vehicles as the secretary of
 3 revenue shall deem proper.

4 (4) A transporter delivering vehicles not the transporter's own by the
 5 driveaway method where such vehicles are being driven, towed, or
 6 transported singly, or by the saddlemount, towbar, or fullmount methods,
 7 or by any lawful combination thereof, may apply for license plates which
 8 may be transferred from one such vehicle or combination to another for
 9 each delivery without further registration, and the annual license fee for
 10 such license plate shall be as follows:

11 (A) Prior to January 1, 2013:

20 (5) A truck or truck tractor registered for a gross weight of more than
 21 12,000 pounds, which is operated wholly within the corporate limits of a
 22 city or village or within a radius of 25 miles beyond the corporate limits,
 23 shall be classified as a local truck except that in no event shall such
 24 vehicles operated as contract or common carriers outside a radius of three
 25 miles beyond the corporate limits of the city or village in which such
 26 vehicles were based when registered and licensed be considered local
 27 trucks or truck tractors. The secretary of revenue is hereby authorized and
 28 directed to adopt rules and regulations prescribing a procedure for the
 29 issuance of permits by the division of vehicles whereby owners of local
 30 trucks or truck tractors may operate any such vehicle, empty, beyond the
 31 radius hereinbefore prescribed, when such operation is solely for the
 32 purpose of having such vehicle repaired, painted or serviced or for adding
 33 additional equipment thereto. The annual license fee for a local truck or
 34 truck tractor, except as otherwise provided herein, shall be as follows:

11 A vehicle licensed as a farm truck or truck tractor may be used by the

12 owner thereof to transport, for charity and without compensation of any

13 kind, commodities for religious or educational institutions. A truck which

14 is licensed as a farm truck may also be used for the transportation of sand,

15 gravel, slag stone, limestone, crushed stone, cinders, black top, dirt or fill

16 material to a township road maintenance or construction site of the

17 township in which the owner of such truck resides. Any applicant for

18 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used in combination

19 with a trailer or semitrailer shall register the farm truck or farm truck

20 tractor for a gross weight which shall include the empty weight of the

21 truck or truck tractor or of the combination of any truck or truck tractor

22 and any type of trailer or semitrailer, plus the maximum weight of cargo

23 which will be transported on or with the same. The applicant for

24 registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor used to transport a

25 gross weight of more than 54,000 pounds shall durably letter on the side of

26 the motor vehicle the words "farm vehicle—not for hire." If an applicant

27 for registration of any farm truck or farm truck tractor operates such

28 vehicle for any use or purpose not authorized for a farm truck or farm

29 truck tractor, such applicant shall pay an additional fee equal to the fee

30 required for the registration of all trucks or truck tractors not registered as

31 local, 6,000-mile or farm truck or farm truck tractor motor vehicles, less

32 the amount of the fee paid at time of registration. Nothing in this or the

33 preceding paragraph shall authorize a gross weight of a vehicle or

34 combination of vehicles on the national system of interstate and defense

35 highways greater than permitted by laws of the United States congress.

36 (7) Except as hereinafter provided, the annual license fee for each

37 local urban transit bus used in local urban transit operations exempted

38 under the provisions of ~~subsection (a)~~ of K.S.A. 66-1,109(a), and

39 amendments thereto, shall be based on the passenger seating capacity of

40 the bus and shall be as follows:

41 (A) Prior to January 1, 2013:

42 8 or more, but less than 31 passengers\$15

43 31 or more, but less than 40 passengers30

1 More than 39 passengers60
2 (B) On January 1, 2013, through December 31, 2013:
3 8 or more, but less than 31 passengers\$25
4 31 or more, but less than 40 passengers40
5 More than 39 passengers70
6 (C) On January 1, 2014:
7 8 or more, but less than 31 passengers\$35
8 31 or more, but less than 40 passengers50
9 More than 39 passengers80

10 The annual license fee for each local urban transit bus which is owned
11 by a metropolitan transit authority established pursuant to articles 25 and
12 28 of chapter 12 or pursuant to article 31 of chapter 13 of the Kansas
13 Statutes Annotated, and amendments thereto, shall be \$2.

14 (8) For licensing purposes, station wagons with a carrying capacity of
15 less than 10 passengers shall be subject to registration fees based on the
16 weight of the vehicles, as provided in subsection (a). Station wagons with
17 a carrying capacity of 10 or more passengers shall be subject to the truck
18 classifications and license fees as provided.

19 (9) For any trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer or pole trailer the annual
20 license fee shall be as follows:

21 (A) (i) Until January 1, 2013, for any such vehicle with a gross
22 weight of more than 12,000 pounds the annual fee shall be \$35;

23 (ii) on January 1, 2013, For any such vehicle with a gross weight of
24 more than 12,000 pounds but less than 54,000 pounds the annual fee shall
25 be \$45, on January 1, 2014, \$55;

26 (B) any such vehicle grossing more than 8,000 pounds but not over
27 12,000 pounds, the annual fee shall be \$25, on January 1, 2013, \$35, on
28 January 1, 2014, \$45;

29 (C) for any such vehicle grossing more than 2,000 pounds but not
30 over 8,000 pounds, the annual fee shall be \$15, on January 1, 2013, \$25,
31 on January 1, 2014, \$35.

32 Any such vehicle having a gross weight of 2,000 pounds or less may, at
33 the owner's option, be registered and the fee for such registration shall be
34 as provided in paragraph (C).

35 Any trailer, semitrailer or travel trailer owned by a nonresident of this
36 state and based in another state, which is properly registered and licensed
37 in the state of residence of the owner or in the state where based, may be
38 operated in this state without being registered or licensed in this state if the
39 truck or truck tractor propelling the same is properly registered and
40 licensed in this state, or is registered and licensed in some other state and
41 is entitled to reciprocal privileges of operation in this state, but this
42 provision shall not apply to any trailer or semitrailer owned by a
43 nonresident of this state when such trailer or semitrailer is owned by a

1 person who has proportionately registered and licensed a fleet of vehicles
2 under the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 to 8-1,123, inclusive, and
3 amendments thereto, or under the terms of any reciprocal or proration
4 agreement made pursuant thereto.

5 At the option of the owner, any trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer, with a
6 gross weight of more than 12,000 pounds, may be issued a multi-year
7 registration for a five-year period upon payment of the appropriate
8 registration fee. The fee for a five-year registration of such trailer shall be
9 five times the annual fee for such trailer. If the annual registration fee is
10 increased during the multi-year registration period, the owner of the trailer
11 with such multi-year registration shall be subject to the amount of the
12 increase of the annual registration fee for the remaining calendar years of
13 such multi-year registration. When the owner of any trailer, semitrailer or
14 pole trailer registered under this multi-year provision transfers or assigns
15 the title, or interest thereto, the registration of such trailer shall expire. The
16 owner shall remove the license plate from such trailer and forward the
17 license plate to the division of vehicles or may have such license plate
18 assigned to another trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer upon the payment of
19 fees required by law. Any owner of a trailer, semitrailer or pole trailer
20 where the multi-year registration fee has been paid and the trailer is sold,
21 junked, repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by
22 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
23 to another trailer, may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
24 remaining calendar years by making application to the division of vehicles
25 on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of vehicles. The
26 secretary of revenue may adopt such rules and regulations necessary to
27 implement the multi-year registration of such trailers, semitrailers and pole
28 trailers.

29 (c) Any truck or truck tractor having a gross weight of 4,000 pounds
30 or over, using solid tires, shall pay a license fee of double the amount
31 herein charged. The annual fees herein provided for trucks, truck tractors
32 and trailers not subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, shall be
33 due January 1 of each year and payable on or before the last day of
34 February in each year. If the fee is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1
35 shall be added to the fee charged herein for each month or fraction thereof
36 and until December 31 of each registration year. The annual registration
37 fee for all passenger vehicles and vehicles subject to K.S.A. 8-134a, and
38 amendments thereto, shall be due on or before the last day of the month in
39 which the registration plate expires and shall be due for other vehicles as
40 provided by K.S.A. 8-134, and amendments thereto. If the registration fee
41 is not paid by such date a penalty of \$1 shall be added to the fee charged
42 herein for each month or fraction thereof until such registration fee is paid.
43 Members of the armed forces of the United States shall be permitted to

1 apply for registration at any time and be subject to registration fee, less
2 penalties, applicable at the time the application is made. If any motorcycle,
3 motorized bicycle, trailer, semitrailer, travel trailer, or pole trailer is either
4 purchased or acquired after the anniversary or renewal date in any
5 registration year there shall immediately become due and payable a
6 registration fee as follows: If purchased or acquired between the
7 anniversary or renewal date of any registration year and the first six
8 months of such registration year, the annual fee hereinbefore provided; if
9 purchased or acquired during the last six months of any registration year,
10 50% of such annual fee. If any truck or truck tractor, except trucks subject
11 to K.S.A. 8-134a, and amendments thereto, is purchased or acquired prior
12 to April 1 of any year the fee shall be the annual fee hereinbefore provided,
13 but if such truck or truck tractor is purchased or acquired after the end of
14 March of any year, the license fee for such year shall be reduced $\frac{1}{12}$
15 for each calendar month which has elapsed since the beginning of the year. If
16 any truck registered for a gross weight of 12,000 pounds or less or
17 passenger vehicle is purchased or acquired and less than 12 months remain
18 in the registration period, the fee shall be $\frac{1}{12}$ of the annual fee for each
19 calendar month remaining in the registration period.

20 (d) The owner of any motorcycle, motorized bicycle, passenger
21 vehicle, truck, truck tractor, trailer, semitrailer, or electrically propelled
22 vehicle who fails to pay the registration fee or fees herein provided on the
23 date when the same become due and payable shall be guilty of a
24 misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be subject to a penalty in
25 the sum of \$1 for each month or fraction thereof during which such fee has
26 remained unpaid after it became due and payable; and in addition thereto
27 shall be subject to such other punishment as is provided in this act. Upon
28 the transfer of motorcycles, motorized bicycles, passenger vehicles,
29 trailers, semitrailers, trucks or truck tractors, on which registration fees
30 have been paid for the year in which the transfer is made, either: (1) To a
31 corporation by one or more persons, solely in exchange for stock or
32 securities in such corporation; or (2) by one corporation to another
33 corporation when all of the assets of such corporation are transferred to the
34 other corporation, then in either case (1) or case (2) the corporation shall
35 be exempt from the payment of registration fees on such vehicles for the
36 year in which such transfer is made. Applications for transfer or
37 registration shall be accompanied by a fee of \$1.50. When the registration
38 of a vehicle has expired at midnight on the last day of any registration
39 year, and such vehicle is not thereafter operated upon the highways, any
40 application for renewal of registration made subsequent to the anniversary
41 or renewal date of any registration year following the expiration of such
42 registration and for succeeding registration years in which such vehicle has
43 not been registered shall be accompanied by an affidavit of nonoperation

1 and nonuse, and such application for renewal or registration shall be
2 received by the division of vehicles upon payment of the proper fees for
3 the current registration year and without penalty.

4 (e) Any nonresident of Kansas purchasing a vehicle from a Kansas
5 resident and desiring to secure registration on the vehicle in the state of
6 such person's residence may make application in the office of any county
7 treasurer for a sixty-day temporary registration. The county treasurer upon
8 presentation of evidence of ownership in the applicant and evidence the
9 sales tax has been paid, if due, shall charge and collect a fee of \$3 for each
10 sixty-day temporary license and issue a sticker or paper registration as may
11 be determined by the director of vehicles, and the registration so issued
12 shall be valid for a period of 60 days from the date of issuance.

13 (f) Any owner of any motor vehicle which is subject to taxation under
14 the provisions of article 51 of chapter 79 of the Kansas Statutes Annotated,
15 and amendments thereto, or any other truck or truck tractor where the
16 annual registration fee has been paid and the vehicle is sold, junked,
17 repossessed, foreclosed by a mechanic's lien or title transferred by
18 operation of law, and the registration thereon is not going to be transferred
19 to another vehicle may secure a refund for the registration fee for the
20 remaining portion of the year by making application to the division of
21 vehicles on a form and in the manner prescribed by the director of
22 vehicles, accompanied by all license plates and attachments issued in
23 connection therewith. If the owner of the registration becomes deceased
24 and the vehicle is not going to be used on the highway, and title is not
25 being currently transferred, the proper representative of the estate shall be
26 entitled to the refund. The refund shall be made only for the period of time
27 remaining in the registration year from the date of completion and filing of
28 the application with and delivery of the license plate and attachments to
29 the division of vehicles. Where the registration is secured under a quarterly
30 payment annual registration fee, as provided for in K.S.A. 8-143a, and
31 amendments thereto, such refund shall be made on the quarterly fee paid
32 and unused and all remaining quarterly payments shall be canceled. Any
33 truck or truck tractor having the registration fee paid on quarterly payment
34 basis, all quarterly payments due or a fraction of quarterly payment due
35 shall be paid before title may be transferred, except that in case of death,
36 the filing of the application and returning of the license plate and
37 attachment shall cancel the remaining annual payments due. Whenever a
38 truck or truck tractor, where the registration is secured on a quarterly
39 payment of the annual registration, the one repossessing the truck or truck
40 tractor, or foreclosing by a mechanic's lien, or securing title by court order,
41 the mortgagor or the assigns of the mortgagor, or the one securing title
42 may pay the balance due on date of application for title, but the payments
43 for the remaining portion of the year shall not be canceled unless

1 application is made and the license plate and attachments are surrendered.
2 Nothing in this subsection shall apply when registration is secured under
3 the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,101 to 8-1,123, inclusive, and amendments
4 thereto. Notwithstanding any of the foregoing provisions of this section,
5 no refund shall be made under the provisions of this section where the
6 amount thereof does not exceed \$5. The division of vehicles shall furnish
7 such blank forms as may be required under the provisions of this
8 subsection as it deems necessary to be completed by the applicant.
9 Whenever a registration which has been secured on a quarterly basis shall
10 be canceled as provided in this subsection, the division of vehicles shall
11 notify the county treasurer issuing the original registration of such
12 cancellation so that the county treasurer may, and the county treasurer shall
13 cancel the registration of such vehicle in the county treasurer's office and
14 release any lien issued in connection with such registration.

15 (g) Every owner of a travel trailer designed for or intended to be
16 moved upon any highway in this state shall, before the same is so moved,
17 apply for and obtain the proper registration thereof as provided in this act,
18 except when such unit is permitted to be moved under the special
19 provisions relating to secured parties, manufacturers, dealers and
20 nonresidents contained in this act. At the time of registering any travel
21 trailer for the purpose of moving any such vehicle upon any highway in
22 this state, the owner thereof shall indicate on the registration form whether
23 or not such vehicle is being moved permanently to a location outside of the
24 county in which such vehicle is being registered. No such vehicle which
25 the owner thereof intends to move to a permanent location outside the
26 boundaries of such county shall be registered for movement on the
27 highways of this state until all taxes levied against such vehicle have been
28 paid. A copy of such registration form shall be sent to the county clerk or
29 assessor of the county to which such vehicle is being moved. When such
30 travel trailer is used for living quarters and not operated on the highways,
31 the owner shall be exempt from the license fees as provided in subsection
32 (b)(9) so long as such travel trailer is not operated on the highway.

33 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 2015 Supp. 8-145 is hereby amended to read as
34 follows: 8-145. (a) All registration and certificates of title fees shall be
35 paid to the county treasurer of the county in which the applicant for
36 registration resides or has an office or principal place of business within
37 this state, and the county treasurer shall issue a receipt in triplicate, on
38 blanks furnished by the division of vehicles, one copy of which shall be
39 filed in the county treasurer's office, one copy shall be delivered to the
40 applicant and the original copy shall be forwarded to the director of
41 vehicles.

42 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit \$.75 of each license
43 application, \$.75 out of each application for transfer of license plate and \$2

1 out of each application for a certificate of title, collected by such treasurer
2 under this act, in a special fund, which fund is hereby appropriated for the
3 use of the county treasurer in paying for necessary help and expenses
4 incidental to the administration of duties in accordance with the provisions
5 of this law and extra compensation to the county treasurer for the services
6 performed in administering the provisions of this act, which compensation
7 shall be in addition to any other compensation provided by any other law,
8 except that the county treasurer shall receive as additional compensation
9 for administering the motor vehicle title and registration laws and fees, a
10 sum computed as follows: The county treasurer, during the month of
11 December, shall determine the amount to be retained for extra
12 compensation not to exceed the following amounts each year for calendar
13 year 2006 or any calendar year thereafter: The sum of \$110 per hundred
14 registrations for the first 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$90 per hundred
15 registrations for the second 5,000 registrations; the sum of \$5 per hundred
16 for the third 5,000 registrations; and the sum of \$2 per hundred
17 registrations for all registrations thereafter. In no event, however, shall any
18 county treasurer be entitled to receive more than \$15,000 additional annual
19 compensation.

20 If more than one person shall hold the office of county treasurer during
21 any one calendar year, such compensation shall be prorated among such
22 persons in proportion to the number of weeks served. The total amount of
23 compensation paid the treasurer together with the amounts expended in
24 paying for other necessary help and expenses incidental to the
25 administration of the duties of the county treasurer in accordance with the
26 provisions of this act, shall not exceed the amount deposited in such
27 special fund. Any balance remaining in such fund at the close of any
28 calendar year shall be withdrawn and credited to the general fund of the
29 county prior to June 1 of the following calendar year.

30 (c) The county treasurer shall remit the remainder of all such fees
31 collected, together with the original copy of all applications, to the
32 secretary of revenue. The secretary of revenue shall remit all such fees
33 remitted to the state treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A.
34 75-4215, and amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance,
35 the state treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to
36 the credit of the state highway fund, except as provided in subsection (d).

37 (d) (1) Three dollars and fifty cents of each certificate of title fee
38 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
39 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
40 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each certificate of title fee collected
41 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
42 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
43 hardware fund.

1 (2) For repossessed vehicles, \$3 of each certificate of title fee
2 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
3 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the repossessed certificates of
4 title fee fund.

5 (3) Three dollars and fifty cents of each reassignment form fee
6 collected and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the
7 state treasurer who shall credit such \$3.50 to the Kansas highway patrol
8 motor vehicle fund. Three dollars of each reassignment form fee collected
9 and remitted to the secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state
10 treasurer who shall credit such \$3 to the VIPS/CAMA technology
11 hardware fund.

12 (4) Until January 1, 2013, \$4 of each division of vehicles
13 modernization surcharge collected and remitted to the secretary of
14 revenue, shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall credit such \$4 to
15 the division of vehicles modernization fund, on and after January 1, 2013,
16 the state treasurer shall credit such \$4 to the state highway fund.

17 (5) *Two dollars of each annual license fee imposed pursuant to*
18 *K.S.A. 8-143(a)(3)(A), and amendments thereto, and remitted to the*
19 *secretary of revenue, shall be remitted to the state treasurer who shall*
20 *credit such \$2 to the law enforcement training center fund established*
21 *pursuant to K.S.A. 74-5619, and amendments thereto.*
