AN ACT concerning the offices of the governor and lieutenant governor; relating to vacancies therein.

Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

Section 1. Any governor resigning from such office shall file a written notice of such resignation in the office of the secretary of state. Such notice of resignation shall state the effective date of the resignation. Upon receiving such notice of resignation, the secretary of state shall notify the lieutenant governor.

- Sec. 2. Any lieutenant governor resigning from such office shall file a written notice of such resignation in the office of the secretary of state. Such notice of resignation shall state the effective date of the resignation. Upon receiving such notice of resignation, the secretary of state shall notify the governor.
- Sec. 3. Whenever the office of lieutenant governor becomes vacant as a result of the death, permanent disability or resignation of the lieutenant governor, a successor shall be appointed by the governor, subject to confirmation by the senate as provided in K.S.A. 75-4315b, and amendments thereto. Except as provided by K.S.A. 46-2601, and amendments thereto, no person appointed as lieutenant governor pursuant to this section shall exercise any power, duty or function as lieutenant governor until confirmed by the senate.
- Sec. 4. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its publication in the Kansas register.
