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AN ACT concerning motor vehicles; relating to distinctive license plates;
 providing for the Kansas City Chiefs license plate, the sporting Kansas
 City license plate and {,} the Sedgwick county zoo license plate{, the
 Kansas City royals license plate and the Kansas City current license
 plate}.

67 Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:

8 New Section 1. (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee 9 of one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight 10 of 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 11 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City Chiefs 12 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plate 13 shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper 14 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 8-15 143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county treasurer of 16 the logo use royalty payment.

17 (b) The Kansas City Chiefs football club, inc., may authorize the use 18 of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by 19 this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not 20 less than \$25 nor more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City 21 Chiefs football club, inc., as a logo use royalty payment for each such 22 license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to 23 the county treasurer.

24 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 25 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished 26 27 by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license plate shall 28 pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. Application for 29 registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner 30 31 prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms furnished by the director. 32 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall be 1 transferable to any other person.

2 (e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Kansas City Chiefs 3 football club, inc., license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased 4 vehicle.

5 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made annually, 6 upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments 7 thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132(b), and amendments 8 thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any applicant until 9 such applicant provides to the county treasurer the annual royalty payment. 10 If such annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, 11 and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county 12 13 treasurer of such person's residence.

14 (g) The Kansas City Chiefs football club, inc., with the approval of 15 the director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the 16 provisions of this section.

(h) As a condition of receiving the Kansas City Chiefs license plate
and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the applicant
shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release of motor
vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, address,
royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the Kansas City
Chiefs football club, inc., and the state treasurer.

23 (i) Annual Kansas City Chiefs license plate fee payments collected by 24 county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state treasurer 25 in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and amendments 26 thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state treasurer shall 27 deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the Kansas 28 City Chiefs license plate fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury 29 and shall be administered by the state treasurer. All expenditures from the 30 Kansas City Chiefs license plate fund shall be made in accordance with 31 appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports 32 issued pursuant to vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state 33 treasurer's designee. Payments from the Kansas City Chiefs license plate 34 fund shall be made on a monthly basis to the Hunt family foundation.

35 Sec. 2. (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 36 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 37 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 38 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one sporting Kansas 39 City license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license 40 plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon 41 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in 42 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county 43 treasurer of the logo use royalty payment.

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1 (b) OnGoal, LLC, may authorize the use of the organization's logo 2 to be affixed on license plates as provided by this section. Any motor 3 vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor 4 more than \$100, as determined by OnGoal, LLC, as a logo use royalty 5 payment for each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty 6 payment shall be paid to the county treasurer.

7 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 8 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 9 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 10 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 11 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance 12 of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or 13 lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 14 15 furnished by the director.

(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
 be transferable to any other person.

(e) The director of vehicles may transfer a sporting Kansas City
 license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

20 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 21 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 22 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any 23 24 applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer the 25 annual royalty payment. If such annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the 26 provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the 27 28 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence.

(g) OnGoal, LLC, with the approval of the director of vehicles, shall
 design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this section.

(h) As a condition of receiving the sporting Kansas City license
plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release
of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,
address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to
OnGoal, LLC, and the state treasurer.

(i) Annual sporting Kansas City license plate fee payments collected
by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state
treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and
amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state
treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the
credit of the sporting Kansas City license plate fund, which is hereby
created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state

1 treasurer. All expenditures from the sporting Kansas City license plate 2 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon 3 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to 4 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's 5 designee. Payments from the sporting Kansas City license plate fund 6 shall be made on a monthly basis to the Kansas City soccer foundation 7 in support of the victory project.

(a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 8 Sec. 3. one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 9 20,000 pounds or less, who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 10 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Sedgwick county 11 zoo license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license 12 plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon 13 proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in 14 K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and either the payment to the 15 16 county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment or the presentation of 17 the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection 18 *(b)*.

19 (b) The Sedgwick county zoological society may authorize the use of the organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by 20 21 this section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee may apply annually to 22 the Sedgwick county zoological society for use of such logo. Such owner 23 or lessee shall pay an amount of not less than \$25 nor more than \$100 to 24 the Sedgwick county zoological society as a logo use royalty payment for 25 each such license plate to be issued. The logo use royalty payment shall 26 be paid to either:

(1) The Sedgwick county zoological society, which shall issue to the
motor vehicle owner or lessee, without further charge, a logo use
authorization statement that shall be presented by the motor vehicle
owner or lessee at the time of registration; or

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(2) the county treasurer.

32 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to 33 34 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and 35 furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 36 plate shall either provide the annual logo use authorization statement 37 provided for in subsection (b) or pay to the county treasurer the logo use 38 royalty payment. Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance of the license plate under this section shall be made 39 by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles 40 upon forms furnished by the director. 41

42 (d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
43 be transferable to any other person.

The director of vehicles may transfer a Sedgwick county zoo 1 (e) license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle. 2

(f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 3 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 4 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and 5 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any 6 7 applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer either the annual logo use authorization statement provided for in subsection (b) 8 or the payment of the annual royalty payment. If such statement is not 9 presented at the time of registration or sent by the Sedgwick county 10 zoological society, or the annual royalty payment is not made to the 11 county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the 12 provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the 13 license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence. 14

The Sedgwick county zoological society shall provide to all 15 (g) 16 county treasurers an electronic mail address where applicants can contact the Sedgwick county zoological society for information 17 18 concerning the application process or the status of such applicant's 19 license plate application.

20 (h) The Sedgwick county zoological society, with the approval of the 21 director of vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions 22 of this section.

23 (i) As a condition of receiving the Sedgwick county zoo license plate and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the 24 applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release 25 of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name, 26 address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type, to the 27 Sedgwick county zoological society and the state treasurer. 28

(i) The collection and remittance of annual royalty payments by the 29 county treasurer shall be subject to the provisions of K.S.A. 8-1,141(h), 30 31 and amendments thereto.

(a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of 32 *{Sec. 4.* 33 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 34 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City royals 35 license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such license plate 36 shall be issued for the same time as other license plates upon proper 37 38 registration and payment of the regular license fee as provided in K.S.A. 39 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to the county treasurer 40 of the logo use royalty payment.

(b) The Kansas City royals may authorize the use of the 41 organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this 42 43 section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not 1 less than \$25 but not more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City

2 royals as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be
3 issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to the county
4 treasurer.

5 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to 6 7 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 8 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 9 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance 10 of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or 11 lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 12 13 furnished by the director.

(d) No registration or license plate issued under this section shall
 be transferable to any other person.

(e) The director of vehicles may transfer a Kansas City royals
 license plate from a leased vehicle to a purchased vehicle.

18 (f) Renewals of registration under this section shall be made 19 annually, upon payment of the fee prescribed in K.S.A. 8-143, and 20 amendments thereto, and in the manner prescribed in K.S.A. 8-132, and 21 amendments thereto. No renewal of registration shall be made to any 22 applicant until such applicant provides to the county treasurer the 23 annual royalty payment. If such annual royalty payment is not made to the county treasurer, the applicant shall be required to comply with the 24 25 provisions of K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and return the license plate to the county treasurer of such person's residence. 26

(g) The Kansas City royals with the approval of the director of
 vehicles, shall design a plate to be issued under the provisions of this
 section.

(h) As a condition of receiving the Kansas City royals license plate
and any subsequent registration renewal of such license plate, the
applicant shall consent to the division authorizing the division's release
of motor vehicle record information, including the applicant's name,
address, royalty payment amount, plate number and vehicle type to the
Kansas City royals and the state treasurer.

36 (i) Annual Kansas City royals license plate fee payments collected 37 by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state 38 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and 39 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state 40 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the credit of the Kansas City royals license plate fund, which is hereby 41 created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state 42 43 treasurer. All expenditures from the Kansas City royals license plate

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fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon
 warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to
 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's
 designee. Payments from the Kansas City royals license plate fund shall
 be made on a monthly basis to a charity approved by the Kansas City
 royals.

7 (a) On and after January 1, 2025, any owner or lessee of Sec. 5. 8 one or more passenger vehicles or trucks registered for a gross weight of 20,000 pounds or less who is a resident of Kansas, upon compliance 9 with the provisions of this section, may be issued one Kansas City 10 current license plate for each such passenger vehicle or truck. Such 11 license plate shall be issued for the same time as other license plates 12 upon proper registration and payment of the regular license fee as 13 provided in K.S.A. 8-143, and amendments thereto, and the payment to 14 the county treasurer of the logo use royalty payment. 15

16 (b) The Kansas City current may authorize the use of the 17 organization's logo to be affixed on license plates as provided by this 18 section. Any motor vehicle owner or lessee shall pay an amount of not 19 less than \$25 but not more than \$100, as determined by the Kansas City 20 current as a logo use royalty payment for each such license plate to be 21 issued. The logo use royalty payment shall be paid to the county 22 treasurer.

23 (c) Any applicant for a license plate authorized by this section may 24 make application for such license plate not less than 60 days prior to 25 such person's renewal of registration date, on a form prescribed and furnished by the director of vehicles, and any applicant for such license 26 plate shall pay to the county treasurer the logo use royalty payment. 27 28 Application for registration of a passenger vehicle or truck and issuance 29 of the license plate under this section shall be made by the owner or lessee in a manner prescribed by the director of vehicles upon forms 30 31 furnished by the director.

(i) Annual Kansas City current license plate fee payments collected 11 by county treasurers under this section shall be remitted to the state 12 treasurer in accordance with the provisions of K.S.A. 75-4215, and 13 amendments thereto. Upon receipt of each such remittance, the state 14 treasurer shall deposit the entire amount in the state treasury to the 15 16 credit of the Kansas City current license plate fund, which is hereby created in the state treasury and shall be administered by the state 17 treasurer. All expenditures from the Kansas City current license plate 18 19 fund shall be made in accordance with appropriation acts upon warrants of the director of accounts and reports issued pursuant to 20 21 vouchers approved by the state treasurer or the state treasurer's designee. Payments from the Kansas City current license plate fund 22 23 shall be made on a monthly basis to the united way of greater Kansas 24 Citv.}
