1 AN ACT concerning courts; increasing the credit to the EMS revolving
2 fund from district court fines, penalties and forfeitures; amending
3 K.S.A. 74-7336 and repealing the existing section.

5 *Be it enacted by the Legislature of the State of Kansas:*

6 Section 1. K.S.A. 74-7336 is hereby amended to read as follows: 74-
7 7336. (a) Of the remittances of fines, penalties and forfeitures received
8 from clerks of the district court, at least monthly, the state treasurer shall
9 credit:

- 10 (1) 10.7% to the crime victims compensation fund;
- 11 (2) 2.19% to the crime victims assistance fund;
- 12 (3) 2.69% to the community alcoholism and intoxication programs
13 fund;
- 14 (4) 7.48% to the department of corrections alcohol and drug abuse
15 treatment fund;
- 16 (5) 0.16% to the boating fee fund;
- 17 (6) 0.11% to the children's advocacy center fund;
- 18 (7) ~~2.23%~~2.93% to the EMS revolving fund;
- 19 (8) 2.23% to the trauma fund;
- 20 (9) 2.23% to the traffic records enhancement fund;
- 21 (10) 4.31% to the criminal justice information system line fund;
- 22 (11) 2.2% to the seat belt safety fund; and
- 23 (12) the remainder of the remittances to the state general fund.

24 (b) The county treasurer shall deposit grant moneys as provided in
25 subsection (a), from the crime victims assistance fund, to the credit of a
26 special fund created for use by the county or district attorney in
27 establishing and maintaining programs to aid witnesses and victims of
28 crime.

29 Sec. 2. K.S.A. 74-7336 is hereby repealed.

30 Sec. 3. This act shall take effect and be in force from and after its
31 publication in the statute book.
