Starting on page 1, line 3, and continuing to page 3, line 25, delete Section 1 in its entirety; and

Renumber subsequent sections accordingly; and

On page 47, after line 3, insert the following:

"➔Section 17. The Personnel Cabinet shall, by December 1, 2025, provide a report to the Interim Joint Committee on State Government and the Interim Joint Committee on Appropriations and Revenue, based on a study and investigation of the following:

(1) The number and list of executive branch cabinets, agencies, and departments that allow its employees to telework, and of those cabinets, agencies, and departments that permit its employees to telework:

- (a) How many of those employees telework;
- (b) How many days per week those employees are allowed to telework;
- (c) What policies or procedures are in place by each cabinet, agency, or department to ensure that the cabinet, agency, or department has adequate office coverage; and
- (d) What policies or procedures are in place by each cabinet, agency, or department to ensure that its employees are in compliance with the cabinet's, agency's, or department's telework policy;

(2) What in-person staffing levels are necessary for each cabinet, agency, and department
