MEASURE'S PURPOSE: The purpose of this measure is to bring personalized license plates onto the same renewal schedule as regular license plates.

PROVISIONS/MECHANICS: Section 1 amends KRS 186.174 to modify the expiration dates for personalized license plates such that they conform with standard license plate expiration dates. Standard license plates expire on the last day of the birth month of the license plate holder. Currently personalized license plates expire on December 31st of each year.

Section 2 amends KRS 186.164 to conform.

FISCAL EXPLANATION: This bill has no fiscal impact. Due to the fact that the rescheduling is phased in, loss of current inventory is expected to be negligible.
