1	AN ACT relating to child abuse or neglect.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 199 IS CREATED TO
4	READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section, unless the context otherwise requires:
6	(a) "Abused or neglected child" has the same meaning as in KRS 600.020; and
7	(b) "Child abuse or neglect perpetrator registry, or "CANPR" means the
8	registry for child abuse or neglect established in subsection (2) of this
9	section.
10	(2) The cabinet shall, by July 1, 2017, establish and operate the CANPR for child
11	abuse or neglect. The CANPR shall include the name, age, last known city of
12	residence, a photograph if available, a description of the abuse or neglect, and
13	any other identifying information determined necessary by the cabinet, of each
14	<u>individual:</u>
15	(a) Who has been determined by a court under KRS Chapter 620 to be a
16	perpetrator of child abuse or neglect; and
17	(b) 1. Who waived the right to appeal the determination of a court of child
18	abuse or neglect in accordance with Kentucky law or administrative
19	regulations; or
20	2. Whose court determination was upheld upon appeal.
21	(3) The cabinet shall publish the CANPR on its Web site, and it shall be searchable
22	and available to the public.
23	(4) The cabinet shall update the CANPR every thirty (30) days.
24	(5) The cabinet shall ensure that the following statement is displayed on the cabine
25	Web site where the CANPR is published: "Based on information gathered by the
26	cabinet, an individual whose name appears on the CANPR has been determined
27	by a court under KRS Chapter 620 to be a perpetrator of child abuse or neglect

1		However, information on the CANPR may not be complete."
2	<u>(6)</u>	The cabinet shall promulgate administrative regulations to establish and operate
3		the CANPR, including but not limited to policies and procedures:
4		(a) For compiling, publishing, and maintaining the information required in
5		subsection (2) of this section;
6		(b) For how long an individual shall remain on the CANPR;
7		(c) For how an individual may be removed from the CANPR; and
8		(d) To ensure compliance with all other state and federal laws.
9		→ Section 2. This Act shall be cited as Kylie Jo Sizemore's Law.
