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1		(c) Provide all data collected relating to this subsection to the Center for School					
2		Safety according to timelines established by the center.					
3	(3)	The Kentucky Department of Education shall:					
4		(a) Establish a School Safety and Crisis Line to provide the following:					
5		1. A means for an individual to anonymously report:					
6		a. Unsafe, violent, or criminal activities, or the threat of such					
7		activities at or near a public school;					
8		b. Incidents of bullying, cyber-bullying, harassment, or hazing; and					
9		c. Incidents of physical or sexual abuse committed by a school					
10		employee or school volunteer; and					
11		2. Crisis intervention, including suicide prevention, to individuals					
12		experiencing emotional distress or psychiatric crisis;					
13		(b) Provide the services described in this subsection twenty-four (24) hours a					
14		day, seven (7) days a week;					
15		(c) When necessary, or as required by law, promptly forward a report received					
16		under this subsection to the appropriate school officials and law					
17		enforcement officials; and					
18		(d) Inform students, parents, and school personnel about the School Safety and					
19		Crisis Line.					
20	<u>(4)</u>	The Department of Education shall provide the Office of Education Accountability					
21		and the Education Assessment and Accountability Review Subcommittee with an					
22		annual statistical report of the number and types of incidents reported under					
23		subsection (2)(b) of this section. The report shall include all monthly data and					
24		cumulative data for each reporting year. Reportable incidents shall be grouped in					
25		the report in the same manner that the reportable incidents are grouped in					
26		subsection (2)(b)1. of this section. Data in the report shall be sorted by individual					
27		school district, then by individual schools within that district, and then by individual					

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1		grades within each school. The report shall not contain information personally
2		identifying any student. The reporting period shall be for an academic year, and
3		shall be delivered no later than August 31 of each year.
4	(4)	All personally identifiable student data collected pursuant to subsection (2)(b) of
5		this section shall be subject to the confidentiality provisions of the Kentucky Family
6		Education Rights and Privacy Act, KRS 160.700 to 160.730, and to the federal
7		Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act, 20 U.S.C. sec. 1232g, and its
8		implementing regulations.
9	(5)	Parents, legal guardians, or other persons exercising custodial control or supervision
10		shall have the right to inspect or challenge the personally identifiable student
11		records as permitted under the Kentucky Family Education Rights and Privacy Act
12		and the federal Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act and implementing
13		regulations.
14	(6)	Data collected under this section on an individual student committing an incident
15		reportable under subsection (2)(b)1. of this section shall be placed in the student's
16		disciplinary record.
