0		<u>(b)</u>	"Portal" means a Web site or online database accessible by the public and	
1			electronically searchable.	
2	<u>(2)</u>	(a)	In all counties, the county clerk shall maintain an office for the purpose of	
13			physically reviewing and obtaining copies of recorded instruments.	
4		<u>(b)</u>	This office shall be open to the public for the purpose of physically	
15			reviewing and obtaining copies of recorded instruments at least forty (40)	
6			hours a week in the absence of a portal that contains recorded instruments.	
17		<u>(c)</u>	If a county clerk maintains a portal that contains recorded instruments,	
8			then the office shall be open to the public for at least thirty (30) hours a	
9			week.	
20	<u>(3)</u>	(3) By January 1, 2022, all county clerks shall maintain a portal that allows a person		
21		<u>to el</u>	ectronically file any recorded instrument.	
22	<u>(4)</u>	(a)	By June 30, 2024, each county clerk shall maintain a portal that contains	
23			recorded instruments filed on or after June 30, 1994.
