- 2 Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
- Section 1. KRS 16.065 is amended to read as follows:
- 4 In addition to the performance of all duties relating to the Department of Kentucky State
- 5 Police, the department shall perform the following functions:
- 6 (1) Security of state facilities located in Frankfort;
- 7 (2) Highway enforcement; [and]
- 8 (3) Water safety enforcement as provided in KRS Chapter 235; and
- 9 (4) Personal protection of any Kentucky resident who is a recipient of the
- 10 <u>Congressional Medal of Honor at any public event or ceremony occurring within</u>
- 11 the Commonwealth of Kentucky if the recipient receives an official written
- invitation to attend the public event or ceremony.
- → SECTION 2. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 40 IS CREATED TO
- 14 READ AS FOLLOWS:
- 15 A Kentucky resident who is a recipient of the Congressional Medal of Honor may
- 16 receive personal protection by the Kentucky State Police at a maximum of twelve (12)
- public events or ceremonies per year occurring within the Commonwealth of Kentucky
- if the recipient receives an official written invitation to attend the public event or
- 19 *ceremony*.
