1	AN ACT relating to the establishment of a pediatric advisory council.
2	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
3	→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER KRS 210 IS CREATED
4	TO READ AS FOLLOWS:
5	(1) As used in this section:
6	(a) ''Advisory council'' means the pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric
7	syndrome advisory council;
8	(b) "PANS" means pediatric acute-onset neuropsychiatric syndrome; and
9	(c) ''PANDAS'' means pediatric autoimmune neuropsychiatric disorders
10	associated with streptococcal infections.
11	(2) The advisory council is hereby established in the Cabinet for Health and Family
12	Services and shall be attached to and administered by the cabinet.
13	(3) The Governor shall appoint the members of the advisory council to serve two (2)
14	year terms. A member may be reappointed to serve an additional term of two (2)
15	years after the completion of those terms. Members may be reappointed until the
16	advisory council ceases to exist. The advisory council shall consist of the
17	following voting members and ex officio nonvoting members:
18	(a) One (1) member of the Senate appointed by the President of the Senate, who
19	shall be an ex officio nonvoting member;
20	(b) One (1) member of the House of Representatives appointed by the Speaker
21	of the House, who shall be an ex officio nonvoting member;
22	(c) The executive director of the PANDAS Network or his or her designee;
23	(d) Three (3) parents or legal guardians of a child who has been diagnosed
24	with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the Governor from a list of five
25	(5) individuals provided by the Southeastern PANS/PANDAS Association,
26	who shall be ex officio nonvoting members;
27	(e) The secretary of the cabinet or his or her designee;

1	<u>(f)</u>	The commissioner of the Department for Behavioral Health, Developmental
2		and Intellectual Disabilities or his or her designee;
3	<u>(g)</u>	The commissioner of the Office for Children with Special Health Care
4		Needs or his or her designee;
5	<u>(h)</u>	The commissioner of the Department for Public Health or his or her
6		<u>designee;</u>
7	<u>(i)</u>	The commissioner of the Department for Medicaid Services or his or her
8		<u>designee;</u>
9	<u>(j)</u>	The commissioner of the Department of Insurance or his or her designee;
10	<u>(k)</u>	One (1) representative to be appointed by the Governor from a list of three
11		(3) individuals provided by the Kentucky Hospital Association;
12	<u>(l)</u>	One (1) pediatric psychologist who has interest, research, or experience
13		working with children who have been diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to
14		be appointed by the Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by
15		the Kentucky Psychological Association;
16	<u>(m)</u>	One (1) pediatrician who has interest, research, or experience working with
17		children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the
18		Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the Kentucky
19		Chapter of the American Academy of Pediatrics;
20	<u>(n)</u>	One (1) pediatric psychiatrist who has interest, research, or experience
21		working with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed
22		by the Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the
23		Kentucky Psychiatric Medical Association;
24	<u>(0)</u>	One (1) pediatric neurologist who has interest, research, or experience
25		working with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed
26		by the Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the
27		Commonwealth Neurological Society;

1	(p) One (1) family physician who has interest, research, or experience working
2	with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the
3	Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the Kentucky
4	Academy of Family Physicians;
5	(q) One (1) representative with interest, research, or experience working with
6	children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the
7	Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by any state research
8	university in Kentucky;
9	(r) One (1) physician assistant who has interest, research, or experience
10	working with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed
11	by the Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the
12	Kentucky Academy of Physician Assistants
13	(s) One (1) nurse practitioner who has interest, research, or experience
14	working with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed
15	by the Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the
16	Kentucky Association of Nurse Practitioners and Nurse-Midwifes;
17	(t) One (1) counselor who has interest, research, or experience working with
18	children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the
19	Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the Kentucky
20	Counseling Association State Branch of the American Counseling
21	Association; and
22	(u) One (1) social worker who has interest, research, or experience working
23	with children diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS to be appointed by the
24	Governor from a list of three (3) individuals provided by the Kentucky
25	Board of Social Work.
26	(4) Appointed members of the council shall serve without compensation, but shall be
27	reimbursed for actual expenses incurred in the performance of duties in

1		accordance with KRS 45.101 and administrative regulations promulgated
2		thereunder.
3	<u>(5)</u>	The advisory council shall:
4		(a) Study the benefits of improved awareness of PANS and PANDAS among
5		parents, educators, and health providers and early diagnosis of PANS and
6		PANDAS among health care providers;
7		(b) Examine comprehensive medical and behavioral health services for those
8		suffering from PANS or PANDAS that have been demonstrated to have a
9		positive impact on medical outcomes and have reduced burdens on patients,
10		families, providers, and society;
11		(c) Collaborate and coordinate on data research projects with relevant agencies
12		to identify diagnostic guidelines and treatment options for children
13		diagnosed with PANS or PANDAS;
14		(d) Make recommendations regarding legislative and regulatory changes as
15		appropriate; and
16		(e) Raise awareness of PANS and PANDAS to appropriate entities.
17	<u>(6)</u>	The advisory council shall submit its findings to the Interim Joint Committee on
18		Health, Welfare, and Family services at least annually.
19	<u>(7)</u>	(a) Members of the advisory council shall elect a chair and a vice chair whose
20		duties shall be established by the advisory council.
21		(b) The time and place for regularly scheduled meetings shall be established by
22		a majority vote of the advisory council, but there shall be at least one (1)
23		meeting quarterly.
24	<u>(8)</u>	The advisory council shall cease to exist on December 1, 2030, unless otherwise
25		reestablished by the General Assembly.
