2	Be i	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:		
3		→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 164 IS CREATED TO		
4	REA	AD AS FOLLOWS:		
5	<u>(1)</u>	For the purposes of this section:		
6		(a) "Eligible district" means a public school district located within a federally		
7		designated promise zone;		
8		(b) "STEM teacher" means a public school teacher who is certified to teach		
9		science, technology, engineering, or math; and		
10		(c) "Year of qualified employment" means satisfying a one (1) year teaching		
11		contract with a district with the majority of the classroom time teaching		
12		science, technology, engineering, mathematics, or any combination thereof.		
13	<u>(2)</u>	It is the intent of the General Assembly to establish a student loan forgiveness		
14		program for individuals who are employed as STEM teachers in federally		
15		designated promise zones. The loan forgiveness program shall be administered by		
16		the Kentucky Higher Education Assistance Authority, and all costs associated		
17		with the program, including the reimbursement of any expenses incurred by the		
18		authority in its administration of the program, shall be funded by state		
19		appropriations and other funds held in the STEM teacher promise zone		
20		scholarship fund.		
21	<u>(3)</u>	To the extent funds are available, the authority shall provide eligible individuals		
22		repayment of loans within the Federal Family Education Loan Program or the		
23		William D Ford Federal Direct Loan Program up to a maximum of twenty-five		
24		percent (25%) of the loan balance principal and accrued interest for a maximum		
25		of ten thousand dollars (\$10,000) for each year of qualified employment with		
26		eligible districts beginning on or after July 1, 2021.		
27	<i>(4)</i>	The total amount of loan repayment shall not exceed forty thousand dollars		

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1		<u>(\$40,</u>	000) for a maximum of four (4) years of qualifying employment with eligible
2		distri	icts.
3	<u>(5)</u>	An ir	ndividual shall be eligible for the loan repayment if he or she:
4		<u>(a)</u>	Is a Kentucky resident, as determined by the authority using the criteria
5			established by the Council on Postsecondary Education for the purposes of
6			postsecondary admission and tuition assessment;
7		<u>(b)</u>	Is a citizen of the United States; and
8		<u>(c)</u>	Is a STEM teacher.
9	<u>(6)</u>	The	authority shall promulgate administrative regulations in accordance with
10		KRS	Chapter 13A as may be needed for the administration of the loan
11		<u>forgi</u>	veness program.
12	<u>(7)</u>	(a)	The STEM teacher promise zone scholarship fund is hereby created as a
13			trust fund in the State Treasury to be administered by the authority for the
14			purpose of providing loan repayment as described in this section.
15		<u>(b)</u>	The trust fund shall consist of state general fund appropriations, gifts and
16			grants from public and private sources, and federal funds. All moneys
17			included in the fund shall be appropriated for the purposes set forth in this
18			section.
19		<u>(c)</u>	Any unallotted or unencumbered balances in the trust fund shall be
20			invested as provided in KRS 42.500(9). Income earned from the investments
21			shall be credited to the trust fund.
22		<u>(d)</u>	Notwithstanding KRS 45.229, any fund balance at the close of the fiscal
23			year shall not lapse but shall be carried forward to the next fiscal year and
24			continuously appropriated only for the purposes specified in this section
