1	AN ACT relating to the possession of firearms by persons found to have committed
2	hate crimes.
3	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:
4	→ SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 527 IS CREATED TO
5	READ AS FOLLOWS:
6	(1) A person is guilty of possession of a firearm by a person found to have committed
7	a hate crime when the person possesses, manufactures, or transports a firearm
8	after the person has been found by a sentencing judge to have committed an
9	offense as a result of a hate crime under KRS 532.031 and has not:
10	(a) Been granted a full pardon by the Governor or by the President of the
11	United States; or
12	(b) Been granted relief by the United States Secretary of the Treasury pursuant
13	to the federal Gun Control Act of 1968, as amended.
14	(2) Possession of a firearm by a person found to have committed a hate crime is a
15	Class D felony.
16	(3) The provisions of this section shall apply only to persons found to have
17	committed hate crimes under KRS 532.031 on or after the effective date of this
18	Act.
