3		Section 1. KRS 189.2713 is amended to read as follows:
4	Afte	r June 29, 2017, and until June 30, 2020:
5	(1)	(a) As used in this section, "metal commodities" means:
6		<u>1.</u> Output products from metal-producing industries that are transported in
7		their most basic and original form from a mill or storage facility to
8		market for processing <u>: and</u>
9		2. Scrap metal or other recyclable material used in the production of
10		output products by metal-producing industries that are transported to
11		a mill or storage facility.
12		(b) "Metal commodities" does not include manufactured parts being transported
13		from a manufacturer or supplier to another customer;
14	(2)	The department shall promulgate administrative regulations pursuant to KRS
15		Chapter 13A governing the issuance of annual and single-trip permits for the
16		operation of motor vehicles transporting metal commodities with a minimum gross
17		weight of eighty thousand and one (80,001) pounds and a maximum gross weight of
18		one hundred twenty thousand (120,000) pounds in divisible or nondivisible loads to
19		or from a facility manufacturing metal commodities in this state or a facility used
20		for storage of metal commodities;
21	(3)	A motor carrier transporting metal commodities in divisible or nondivisible loads to
22		or from a facility manufacturing metal commodities in this state or a facility used
23		for storage of metal commodities, may apply for an annual or single-trip overweight
24		permit pursuant to subsection (2) of this section. A permit issued under this section
25		shall be specific to a single truck and shall be valid twenty-four (24) hours a day;
26	(4)	(a) The cost of an annual permit issued under this section shall be one thousand
27		two hundred fifty dollars (\$1,250).

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1		(b) The cost of a single-trip permit issued under this section shall be one hundred
2		dollars (\$100);
3	(5)	Permits issued under this section shall contain a Web site hyperlink or any other
4		method to provide the motor carrier with routes that are approved by the
5		department;
6	(6)	Upon renewal of any annual permit issued under this section, the permit holder
7		shall report to the cabinet the number of trips made and the total miles driven under
8		the permit during the previous year; and
9	(7)	Administrative regulations promulgated by the department under this section may
10		require motor carriers to meet specific Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration
11		(FMCSA) safety ratings and FMCSA safety measurement system scores before
12		issuance of a permit under this section.
