AN ACT relating to attorneys and their non-lawyer assistants.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Kentucky:

→SECTION 1. A NEW SECTION OF KRS CHAPTER 520 IS CREATED TO READ AS FOLLOWS:

KRS 520.050 and 520.060 shall not prohibit an attorney or his or her non-lawyer assistant as defined in KRS 31.100 from possessing a personal electronic device, including a cellular telephone, within a local detention facility if:

(1) Possession of the device is maintained by the lawyer or non-lawyer assistant; and

(2) The lawyer or non-lawyer assistant is not a person being detained within the facility.
